



- Efficiency improvement



#### **3.1 Characteristics**


- They are deposits of banknotes owned by the Banco de España and stored at the CITs premises. Established in January 2005.
- They make the logistics of cash between the Banco de España, the credit institutions and the CITs more fluid.
- They reduce the rate of re-use of banknotes, increasing the return frecuency to the Banco de España.
- Contract between the Banco de España and the managing entity.
- Guarantee: the cash accounts that the banking system holds with the Banco de España.
- Restriction: Prohibition on extracting from the deposits any banknotes that have not previously been sorted by the Banco de España.
- Opening hours: From 7:00 am to 6:00 pm.



#### 3.4 Implications for credit institutions/CITs

- Smaller volume of cash reserves.
- Longer period to withdraw and lodge banknotes at the Banco de España.
- Reduction of the transportation costs.
- Lower risks associated with the transportation of cash.
- Reduction of the processing tasks.

#### 4. The Framework for recycling banknotes

#### 4.1 Characteristics

#### Purposes.

- Authenticity of banknotes
- Quality of banknotes
- Harmonization in Member States in 2007
- Banknotes distributed by ATMs provided by:
  - The Banco de España
  - Professionals if banknotes are sorted by machines to check the authenticity and the fitness
- Requirements of machines to be published in the ECB website:
  - Tested and approved by the Eurosystem
  - Banknote processing in packages
  - Classify without the intervention of an operator
  - Separate physically the suspect from genuine banknotes
  - Check the fitness according to the criteria of the Eurosystem

#### 4. The Framework for recycling banknotes

#### 4.2 Implications for CITs

- Current cash recycling is not allowed
- Creation of a new agent:
  - The professionals cash recycling agents
  - Contractual agreement between Banco de España and CITs
- Publication of professional agents in the Banco de España's website
- Statistics requirements

#### 4. The Framework for recycling banknotes

#### 4.3 Mile stones in 2006

- 6 April Meeting Banco de España-Spanish CITs
- May Publication in the Banco de España web the successfully tested banknote handling machines
- June-July Preparatory work
- September Meeting Banco de España-Spanish CITs
- October Publication of a Circular of the Banco de España:

**Professional Recycling Agents Certificate** 

- November Requests for certificates
- December Establishment of official cash recycling centres

#### 5. Conclusions and Perspectives

- Banknotes with more quality.
- Increase the role of the Banco de España in the cash cycle.
- Closer relationship Banco de España-CITs
- More participation of CITs in the cash cycle.
- Opening of Auxiliary Depositories in Madrid and Barcelona
- Certificate for Proffessional Recycling Agents.
- Official cash recycling centres.
