

Theme 2015: Change


- A typical post crisis the need and willingness to change

General trends


- With some exceptions, the level of cash in total, is still stable or even increasing in Europe
- Cash handling is still rather labor intensive, and there is a clear evolution towards more automatization and recycling
- As a consequence of the reduction in number of bank branches, the cash flow and distributions channels through Retailers tends to increase





Continuous development

- Services and business solutions offered within our Industry are becoming more diverse and professional
- Security levels have improved as the Industry as a whole have improved
- New business opportunities and growth particular in the retail business
- General trend from CIT to CMS





Continuous challenge

- Security levels, requirements and regulations still varies quite a lot within Europe
- A more common industrial standardization towards specific licensing would both increase security and efficiency - cross border
- Industrial development in the direction of Payment Service Provider (PSP) is more likely to become a natural development for ESTAs members
