The Scope of ATM Services

- Secure packing and dispatch of cash
- Secure transportation
- Cross pavement delivery
- Security of the ATM during service
- Securing the ATM once loaded
- Secure transportation of cash removed from the ATM



Audit trails for the ATM Cash Cycle

- Random inspections
- Paperwork documentation for delivery and collection
 - Dates
 - Names of crew
 - Signatures
 - Times
 - Serial number of containers
 - Values



Securing the ATM Zone

- The guideline for securing the ATM zone has been split into two zones
 - Outer Zone
 - Direct attack on CIT vehicle
 - Attack on crew
 - Access to the ATM site
 - Surveillance on crew
 - Inner Zone
 - Duress on crew
 - Forced entry to ATM site
 - Ambush type of attack







Replenishing the ATM

- High risk operation
 - Crew & Cash exposed
 - Operating procedures for ATM
 - Training
 - Use of security equipment
 - Avoidance of routine







ATM Servicing FLM/SCM

- Security Guidelines for First & Second Line Maintenance (FLM/SLM)
 - Training of FLM/SLM
 - Dual control
 - Control of keys



Additional Security Considerations

- Physical site security
 - Risk Assessment (ATM configurations)
 - > On site security systems (CCTV, Access Control, Alarms)







ATM Stakeholders & Effective Partnership

- Effective partnership is essential
- Agreed minimum levels of security
