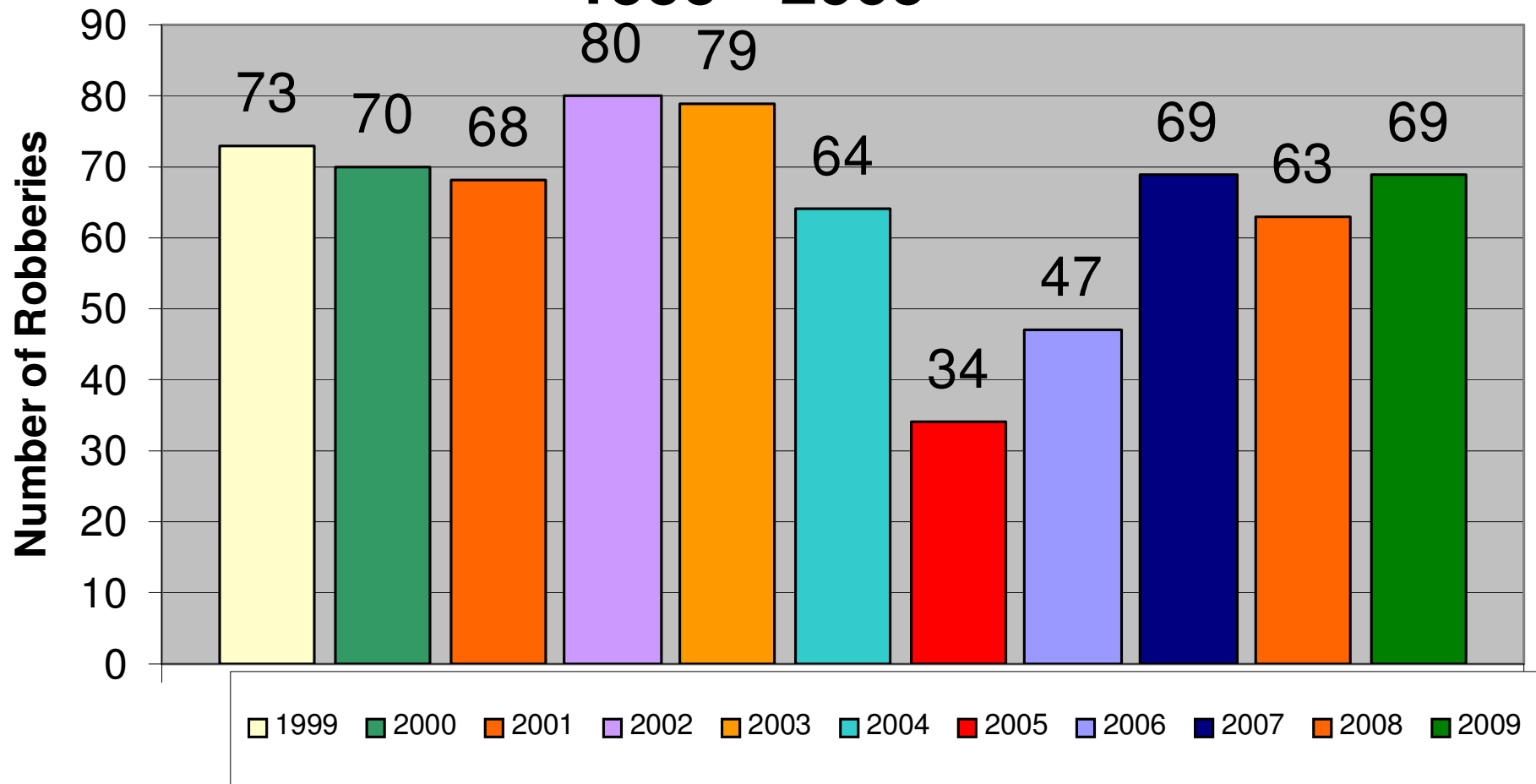

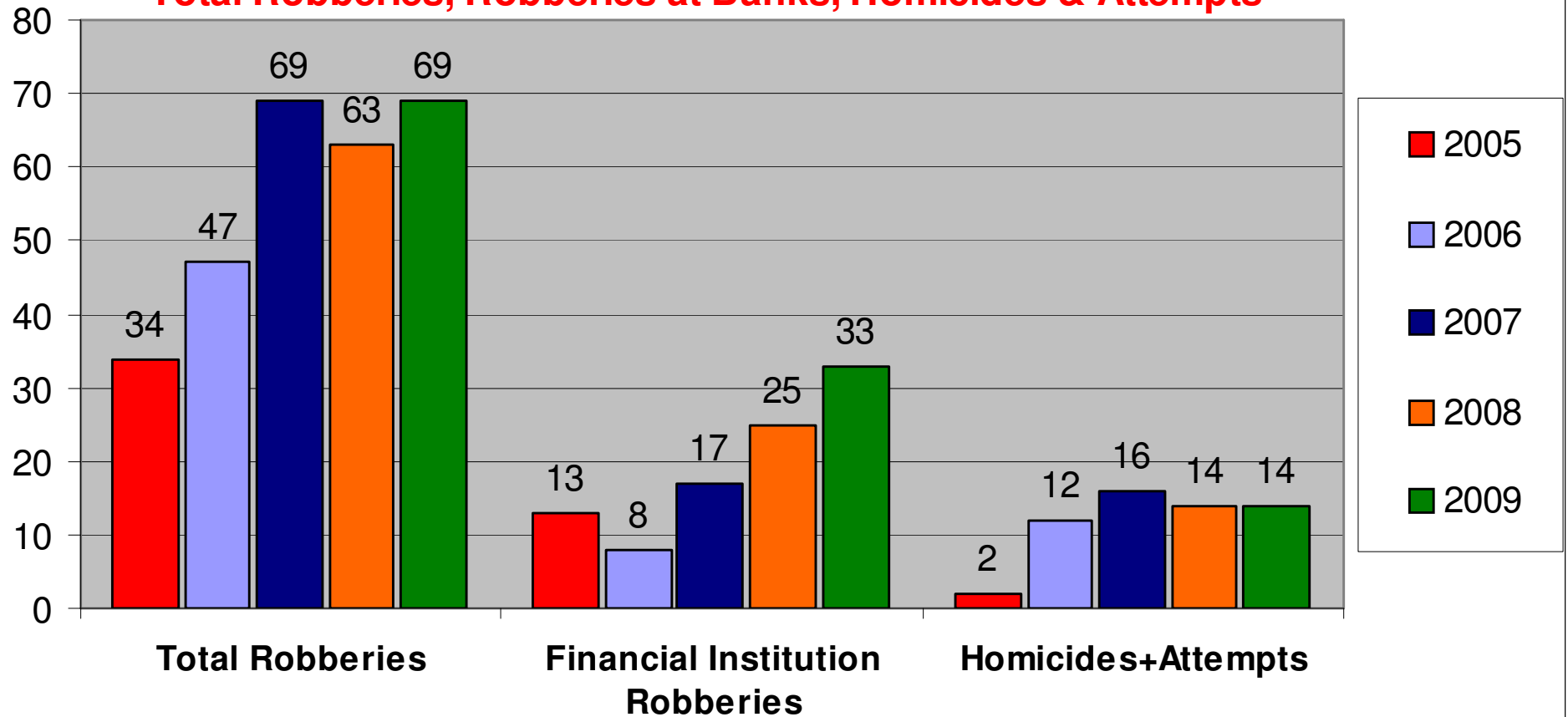
TOTAL ARMORED CAR ROBBERIES

1999 - 2009



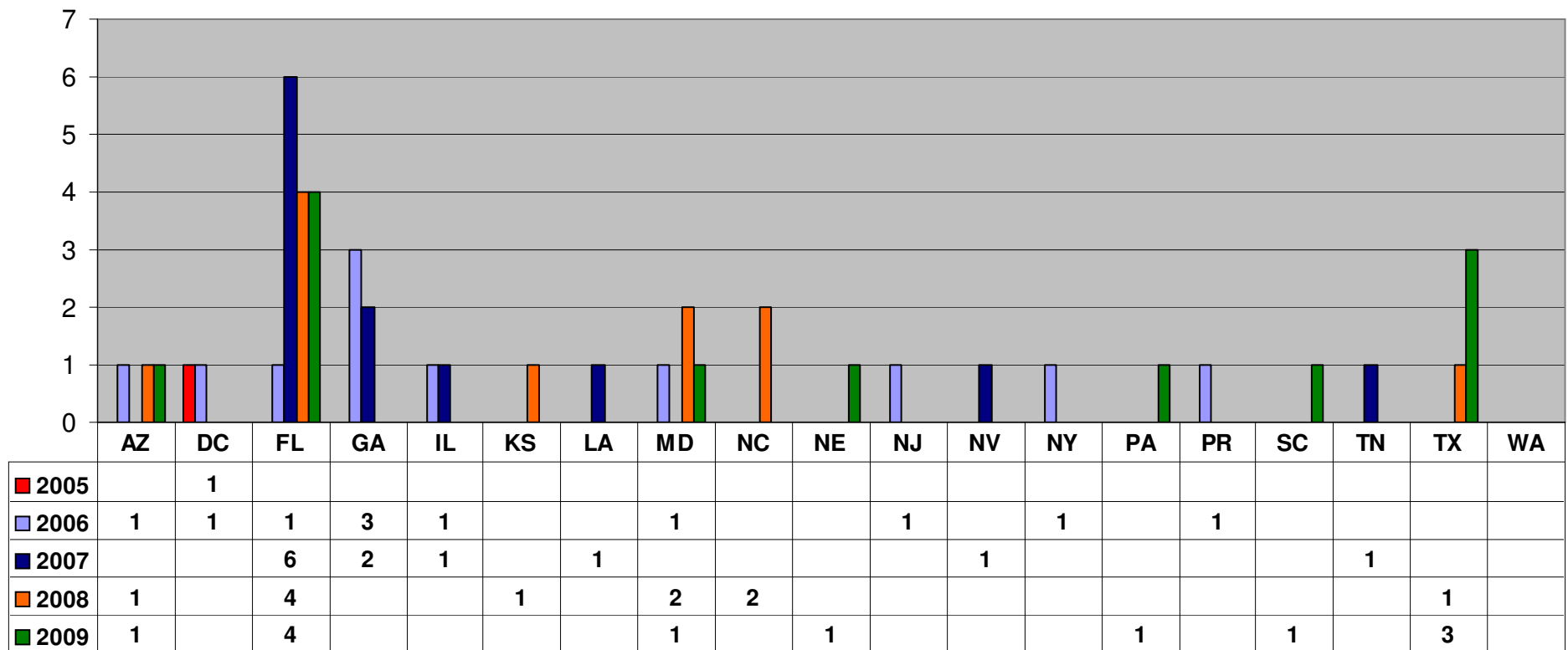

Total Robberies, Robberies at Banks, Homicides & Attempts



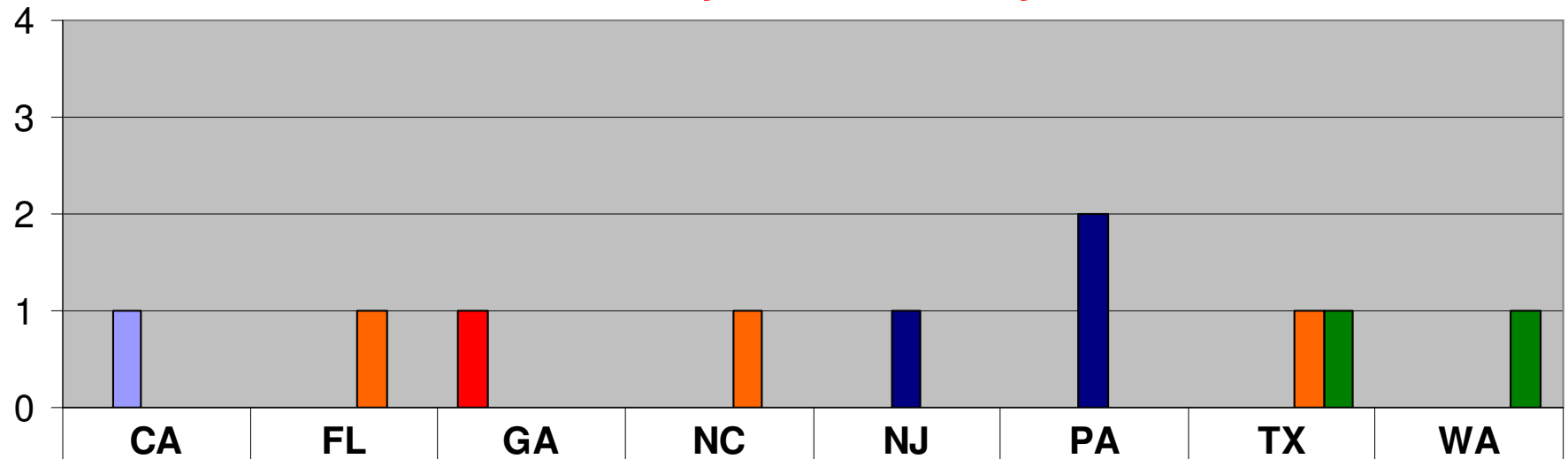

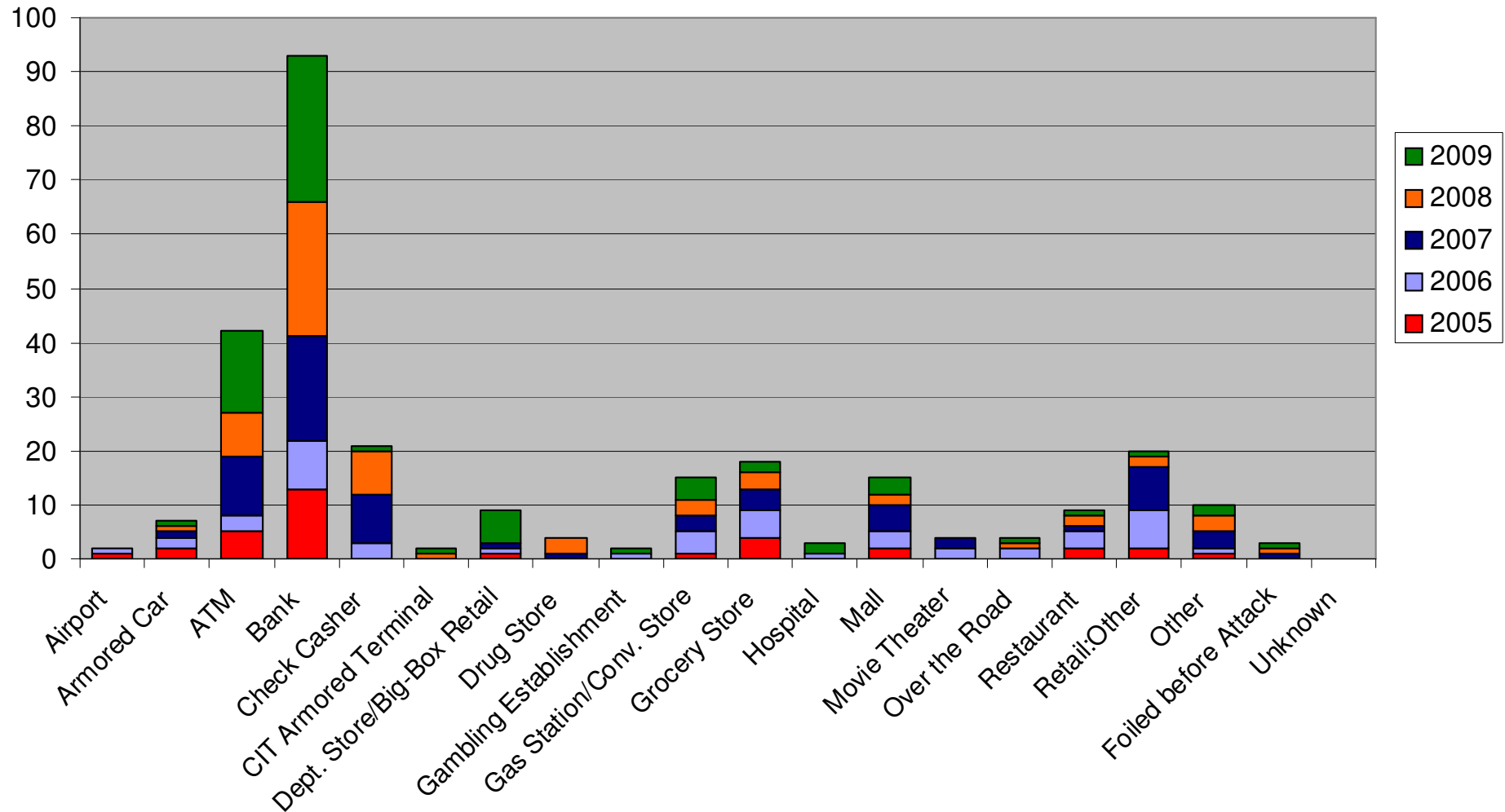

Robberies by Type of Location



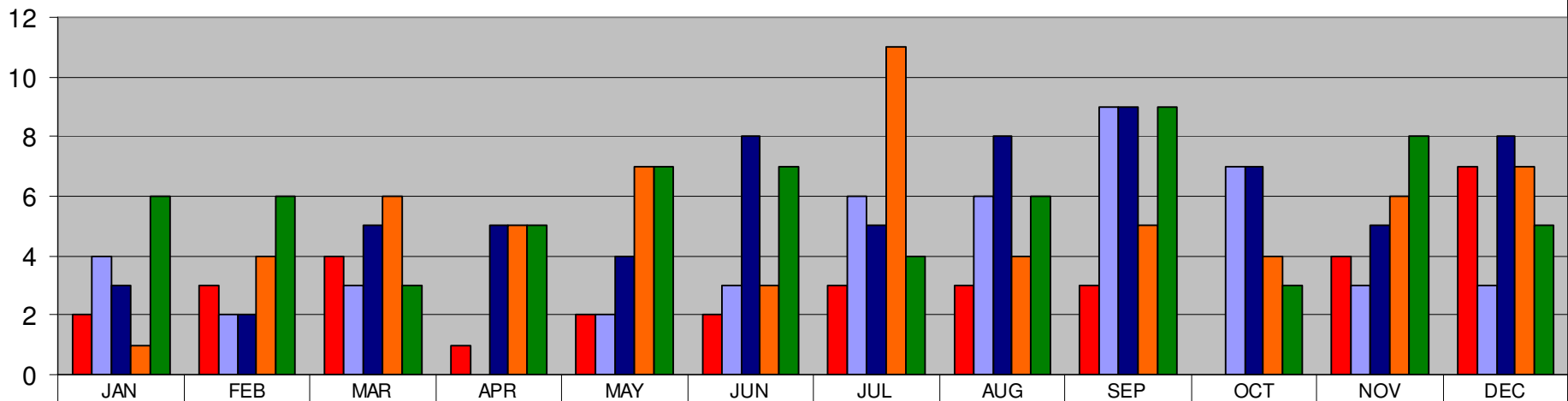
"Mall" generally includes incidents occurring in a mall concourse or in the parking lot as opposed to inside a store.

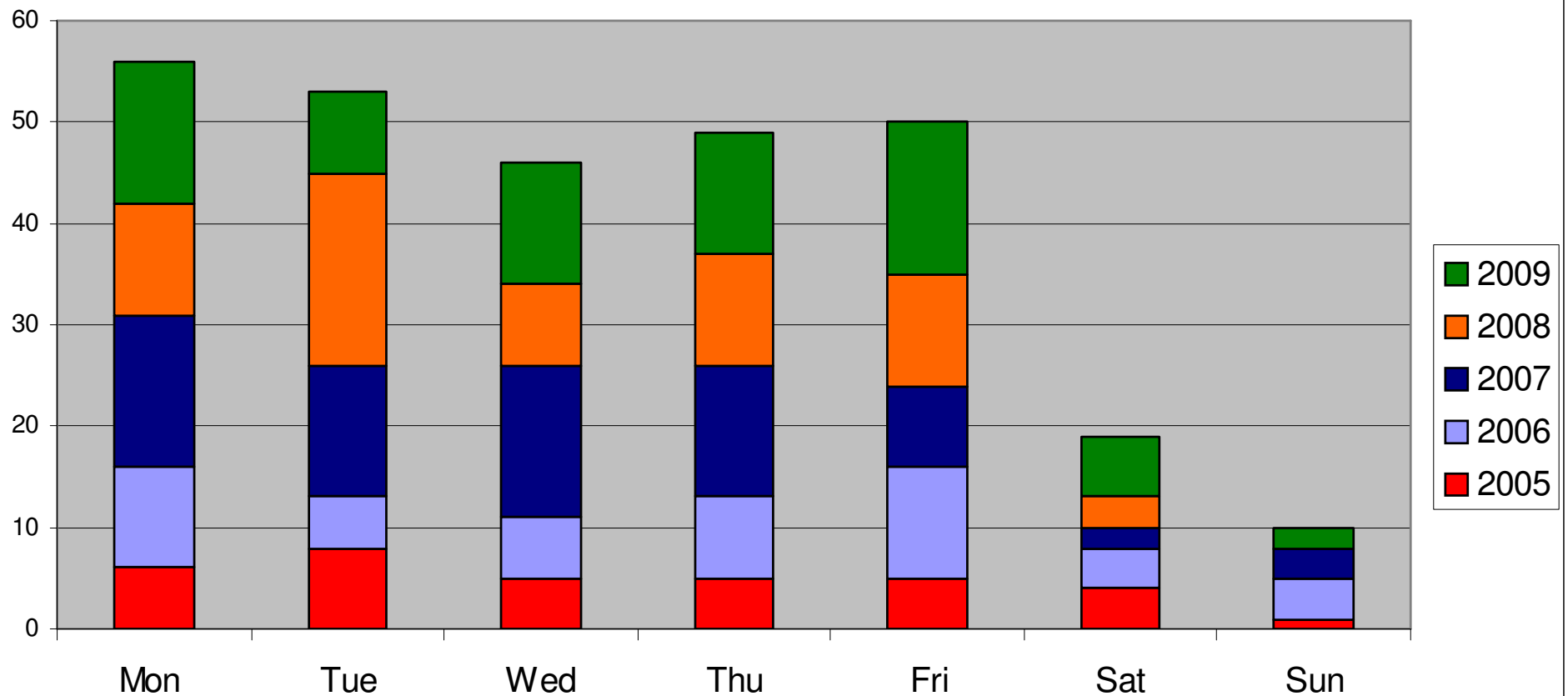

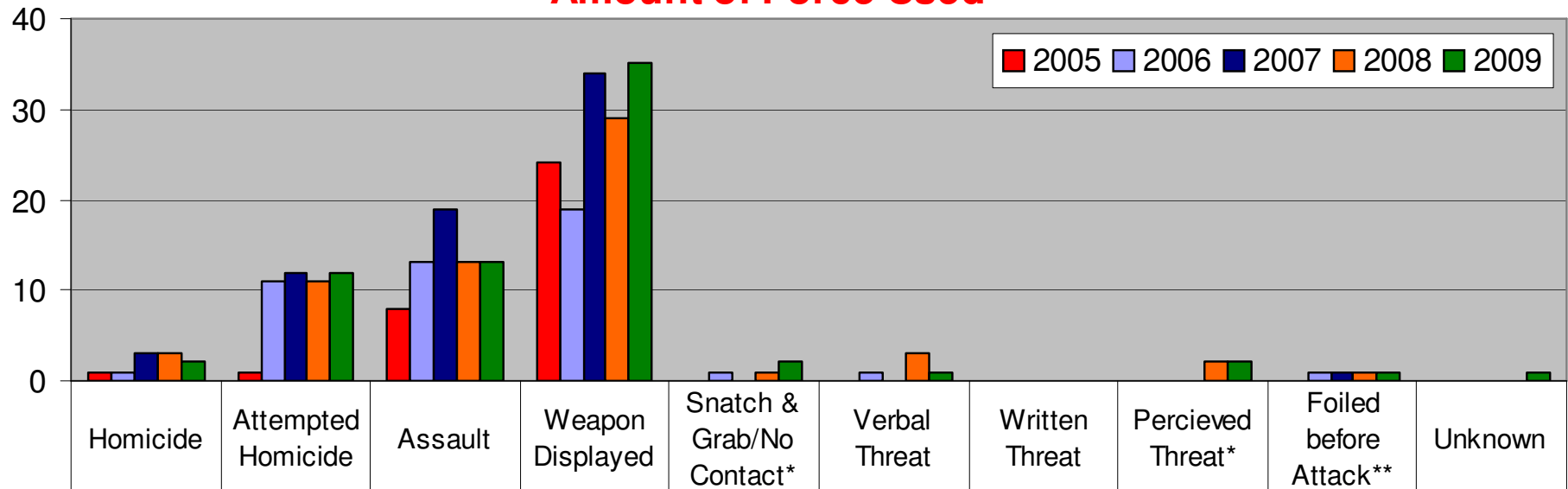

*No physical contact was made with the armored car personnel, .i.e. the bag may have been grabbed off of the ground. Other Snatch & Grab incidents that involve any form of physical assault are included under the category "Assault."

***"Perceived Threat" is an incident where it was believed a robbery was imminent, but didn't occur; a possible suspect may have been identified, but no weapon was displayed or use of force was threatened.

****"Foiled before Attack" generally involves knowledge beforehand that a robbery is in the planning stages, and likely includes law enforcement involvement to prevent the crime from taking place.

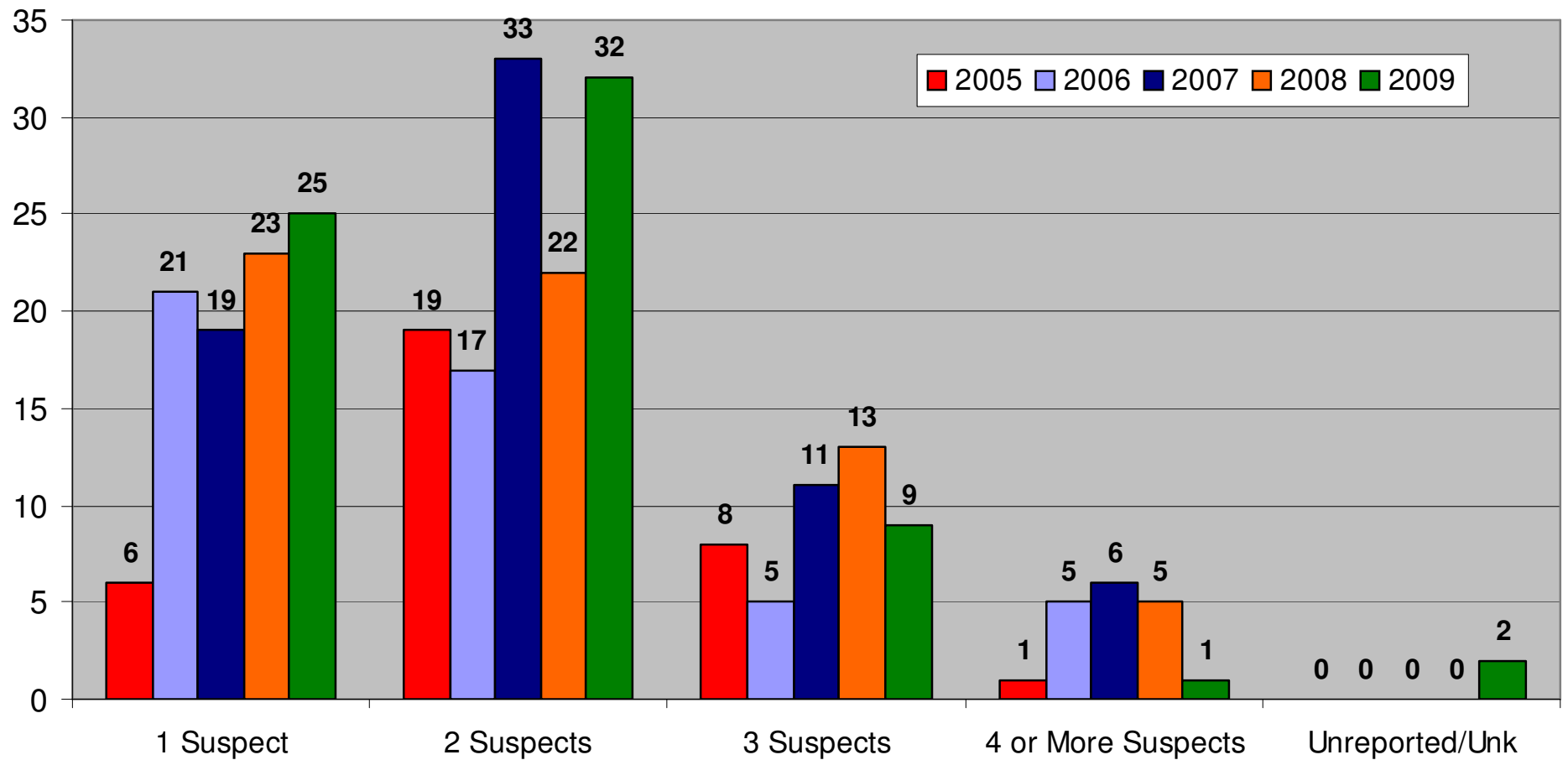

Number of Incidents by Number of Suspects

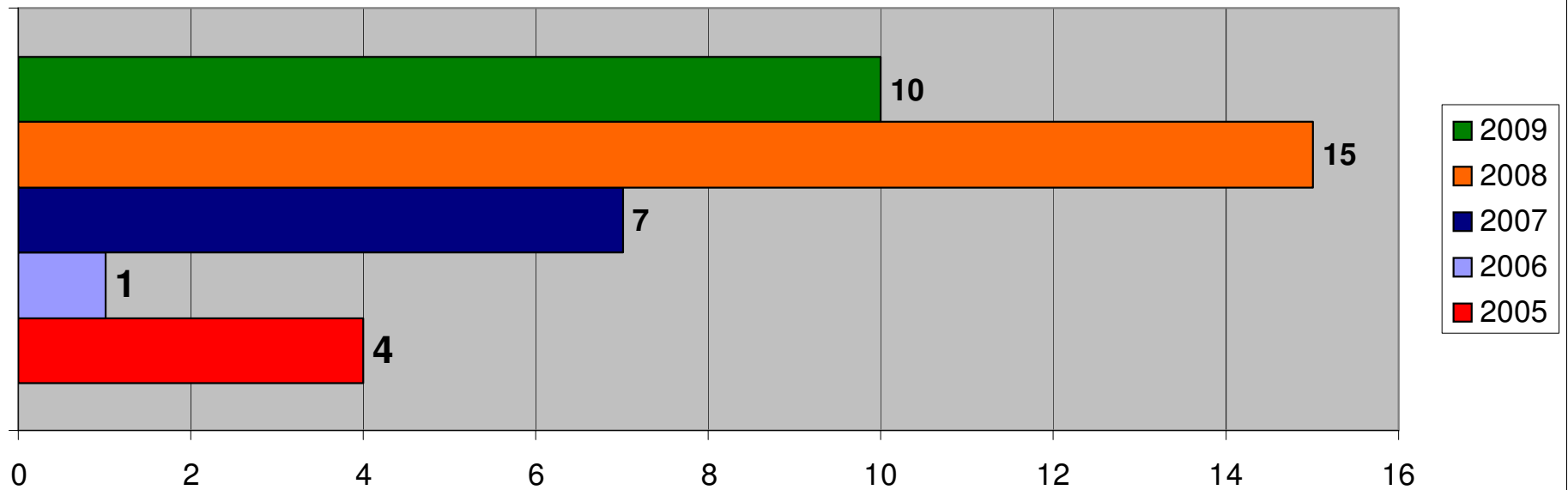

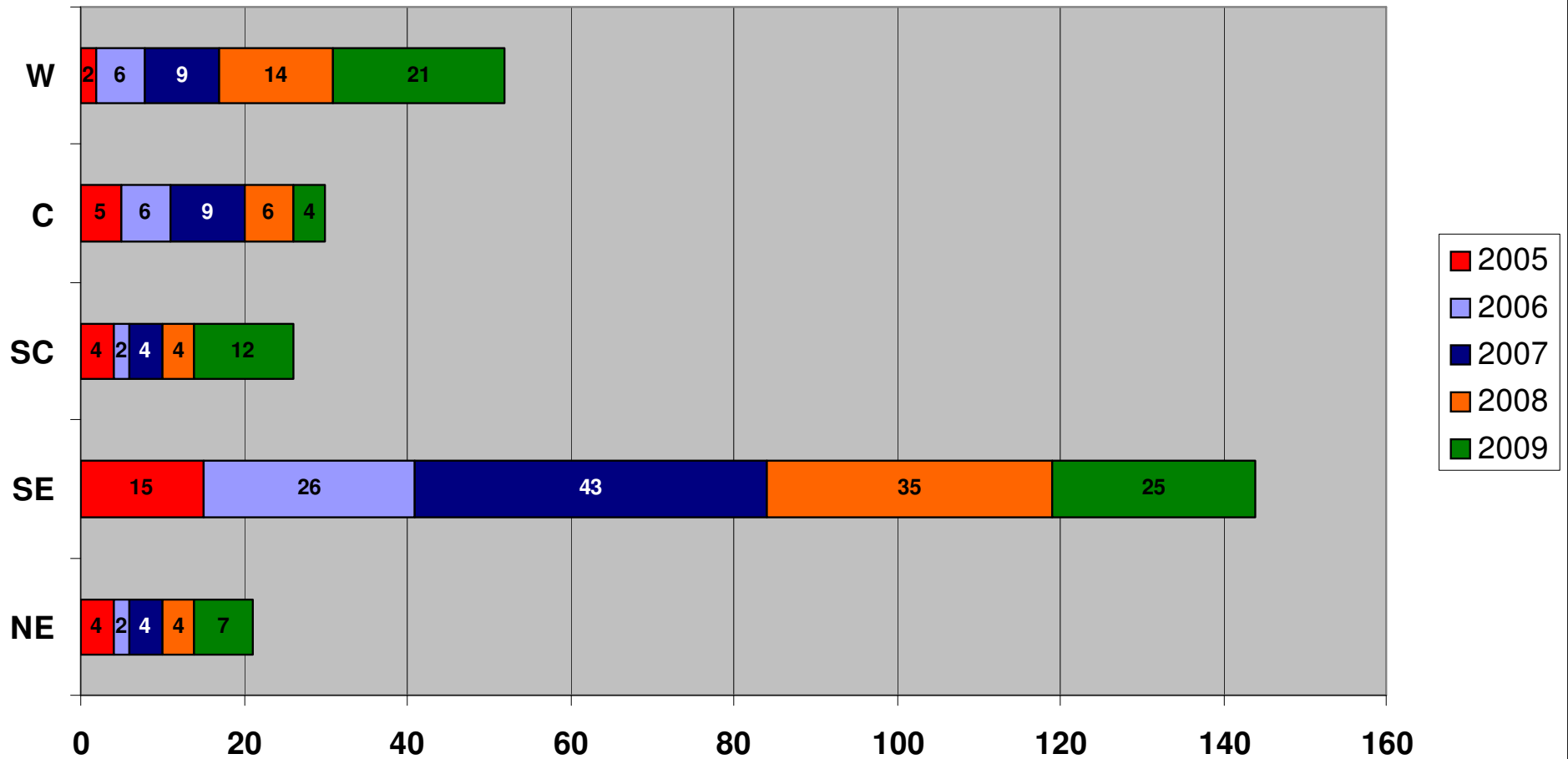

Robberies Involving Assault Rifles or Submachine Guns

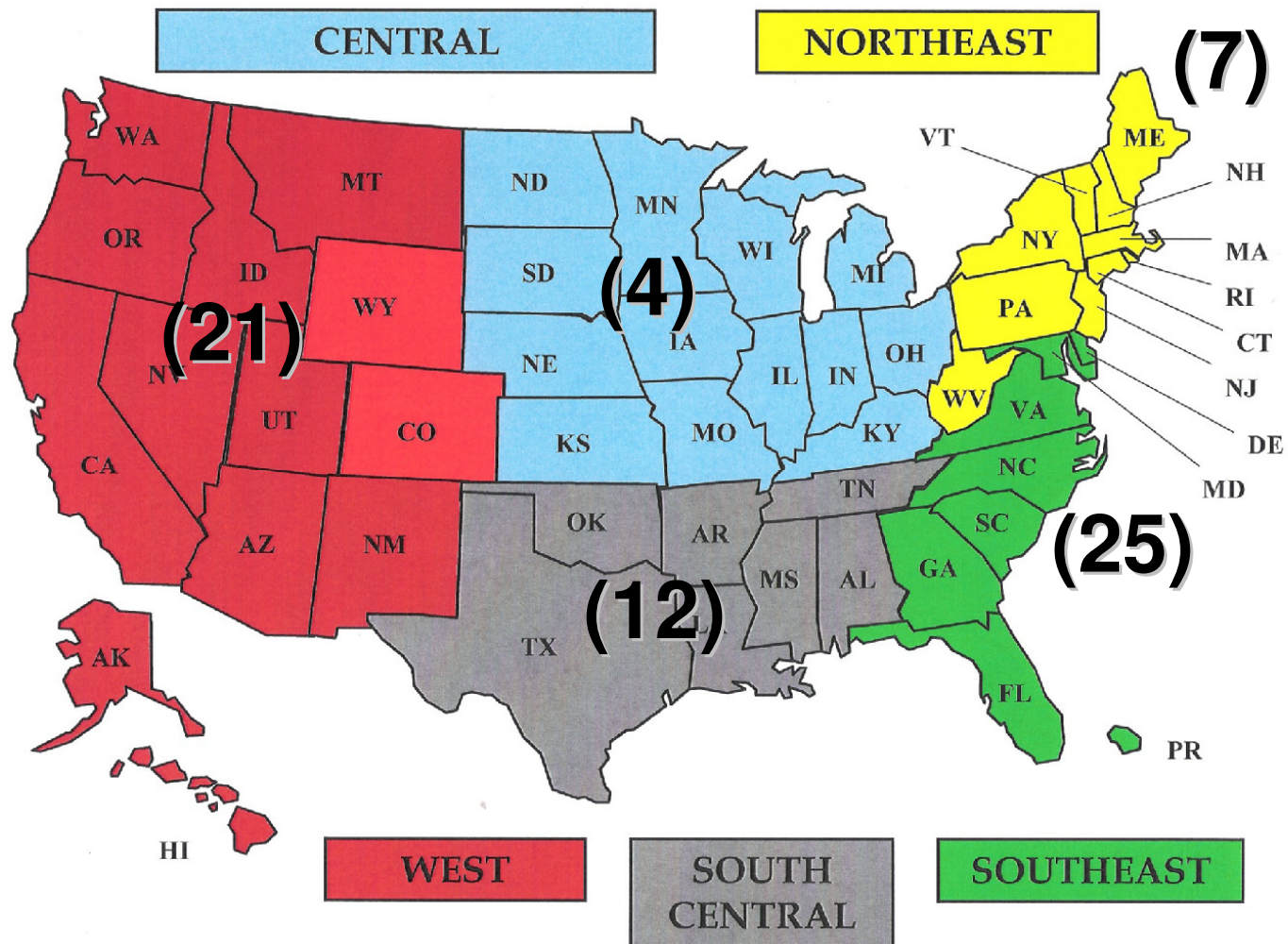

Robberies by Region

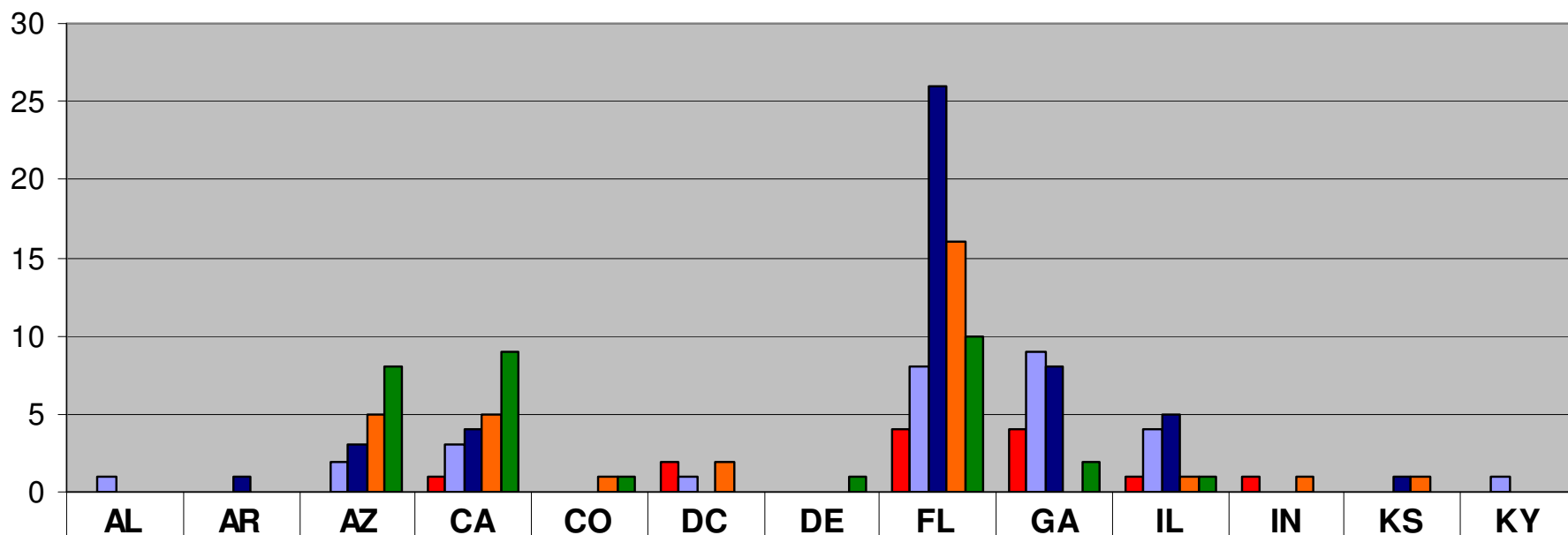

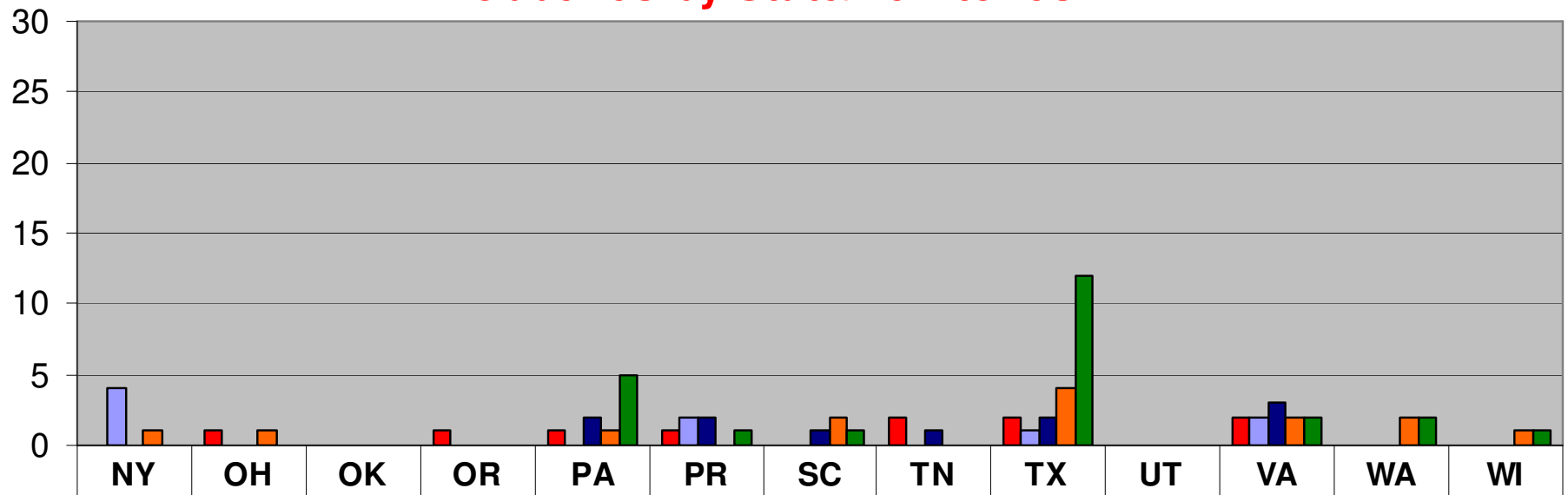

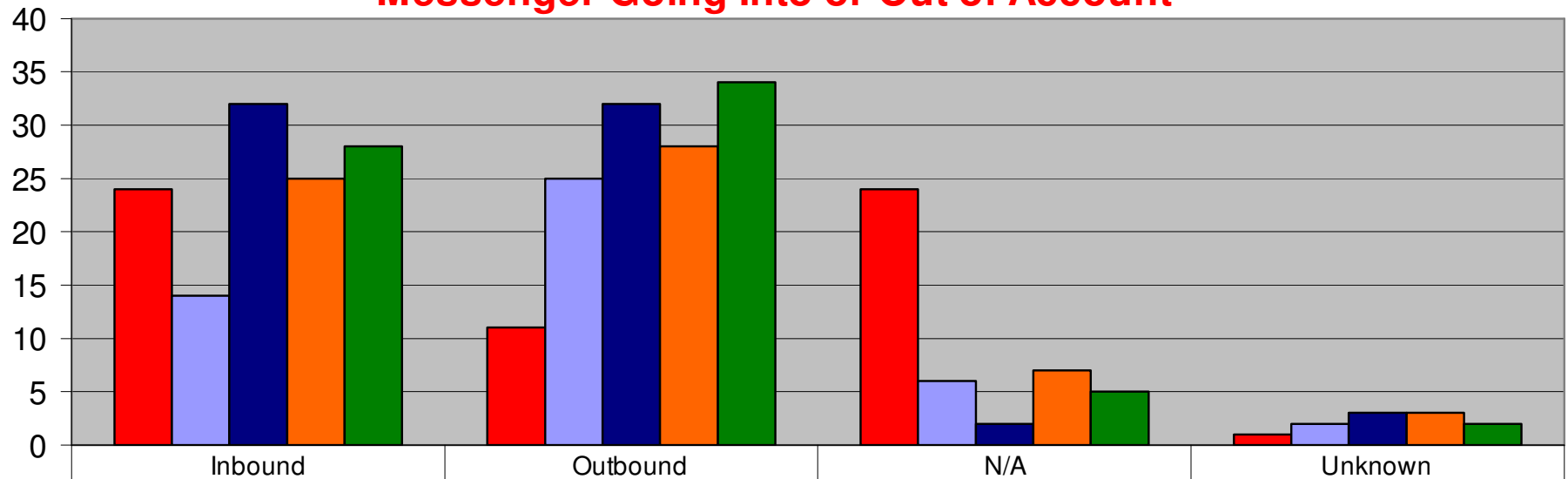

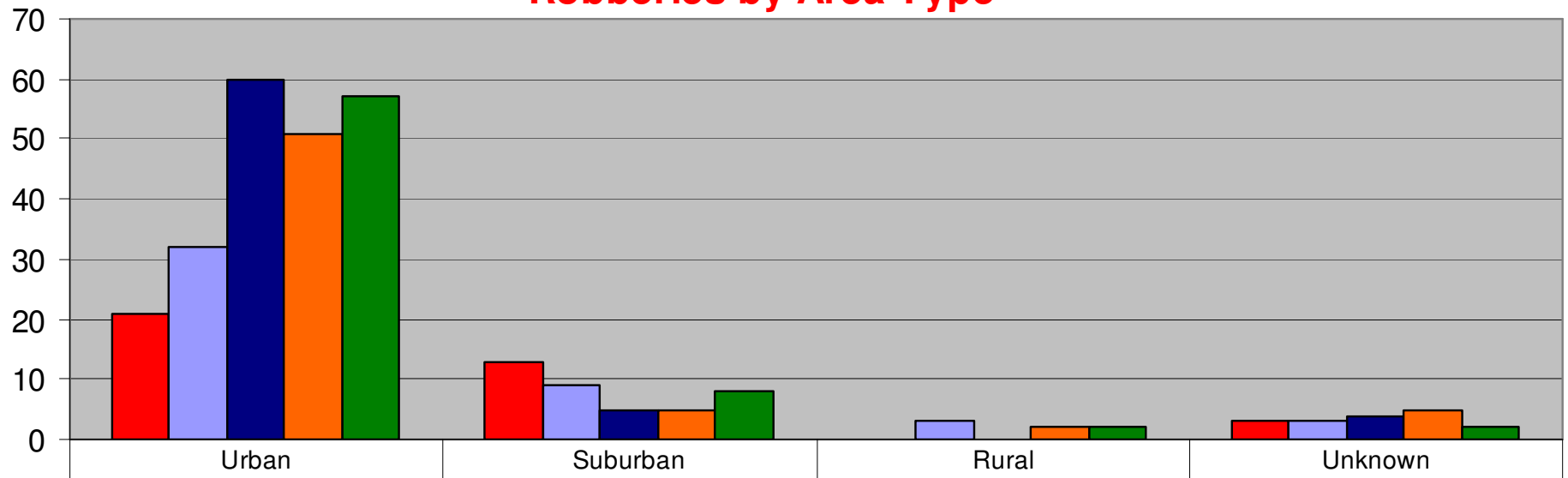
Messenger Going Into or Out of Account

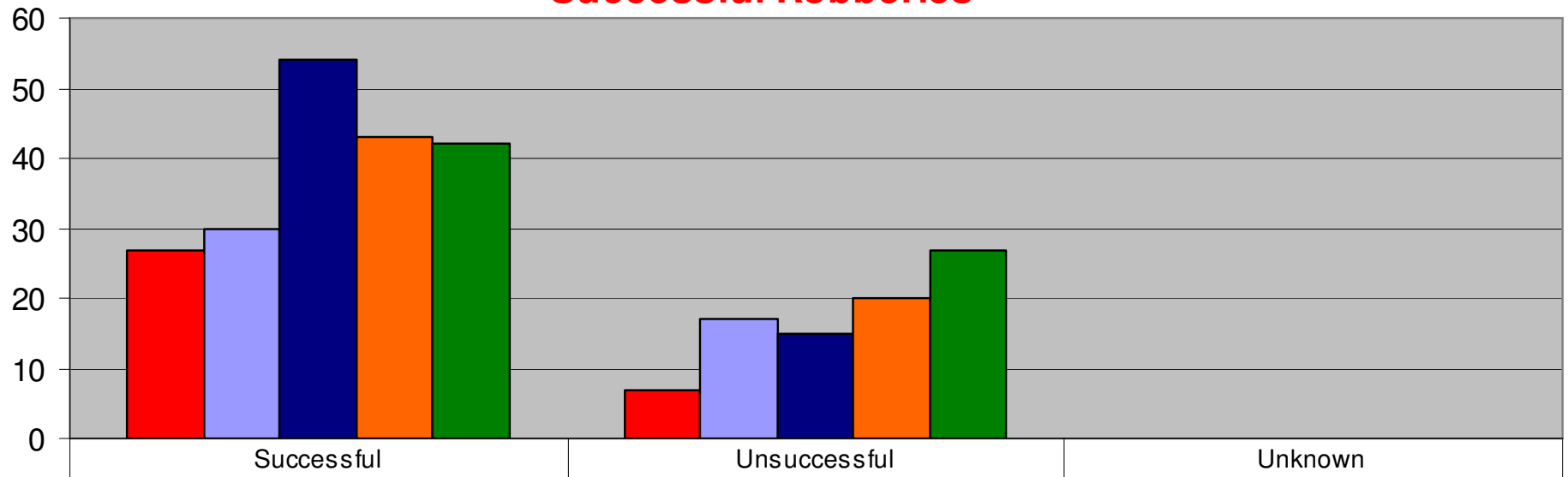

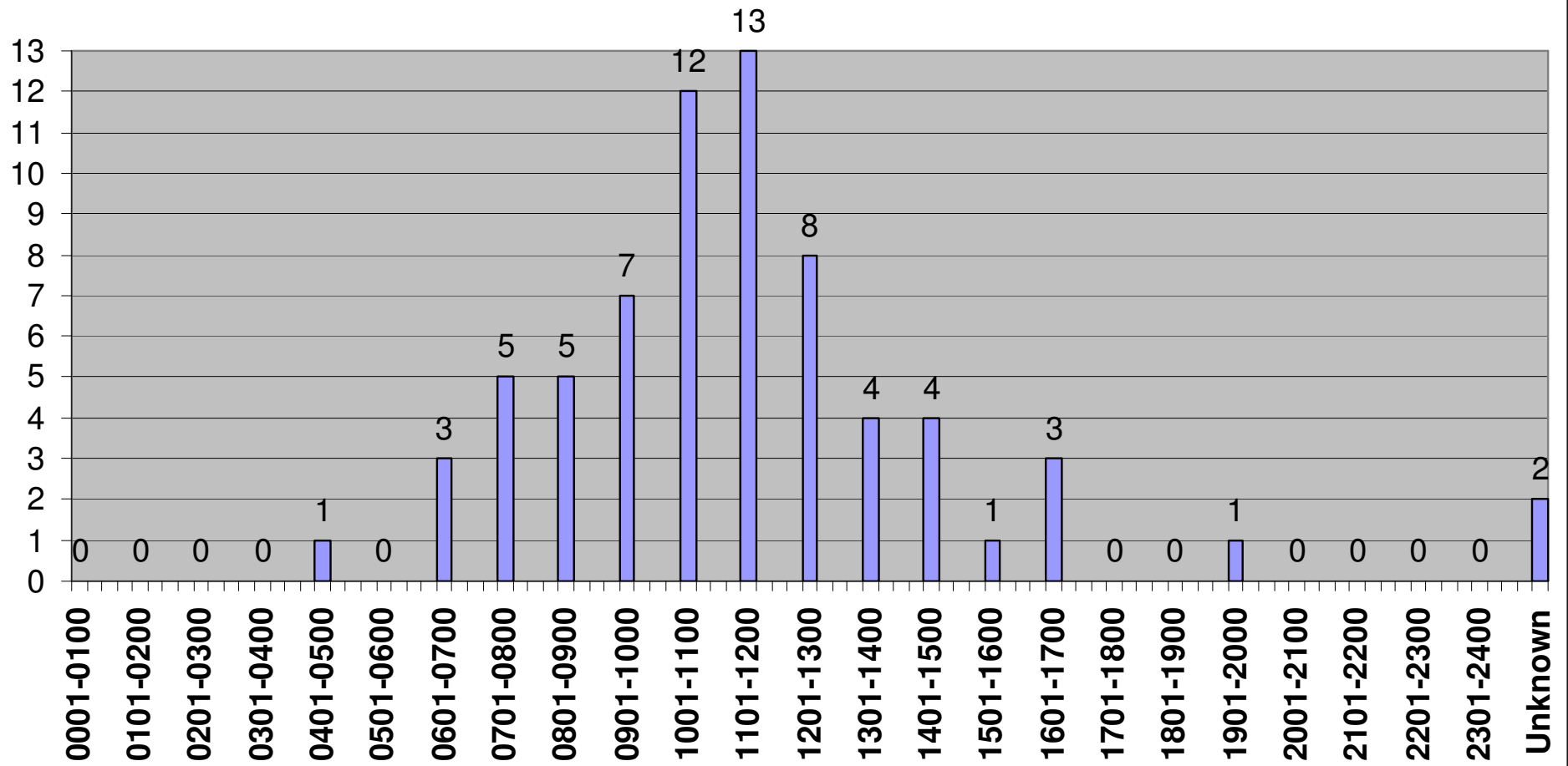

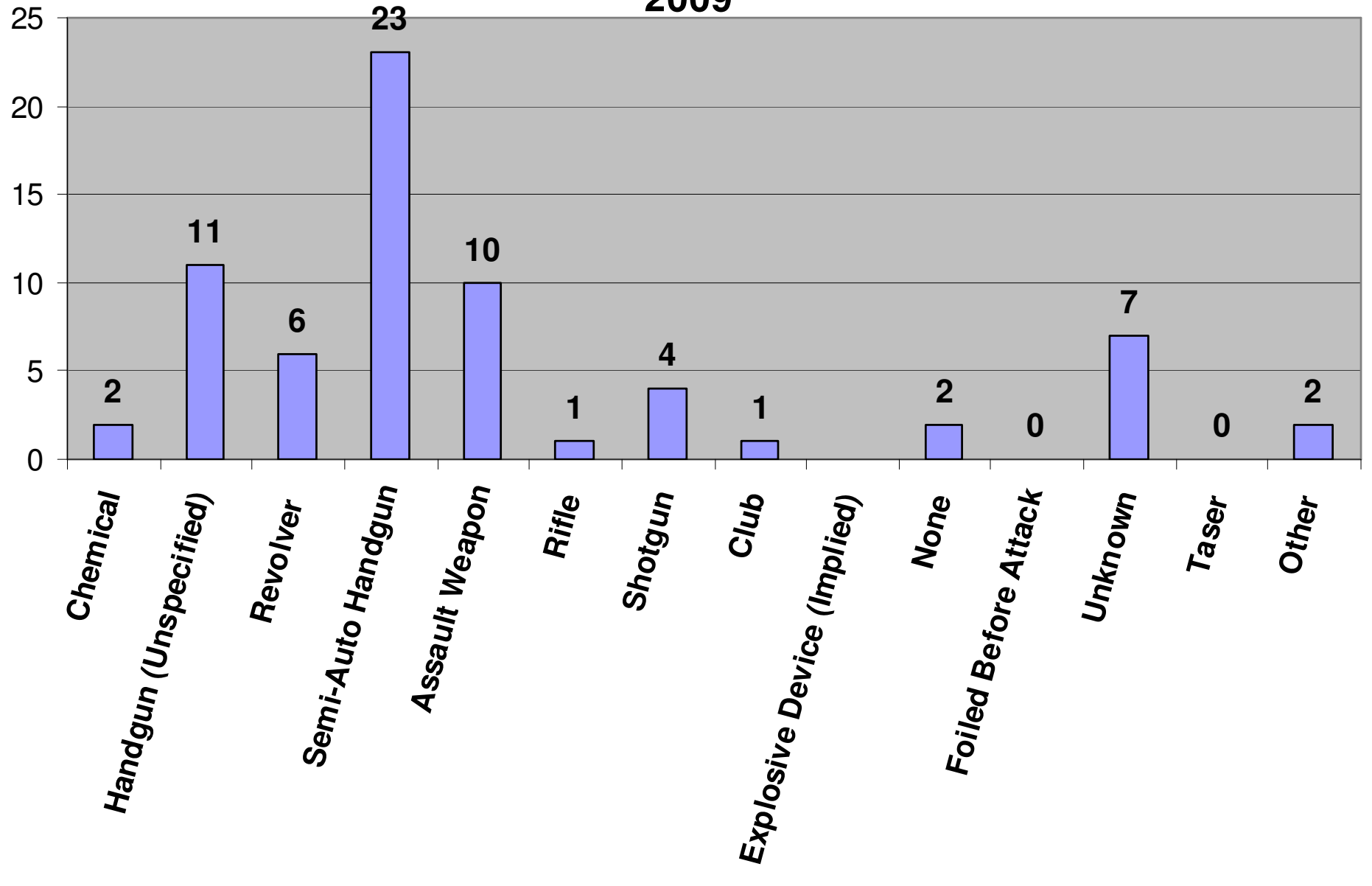

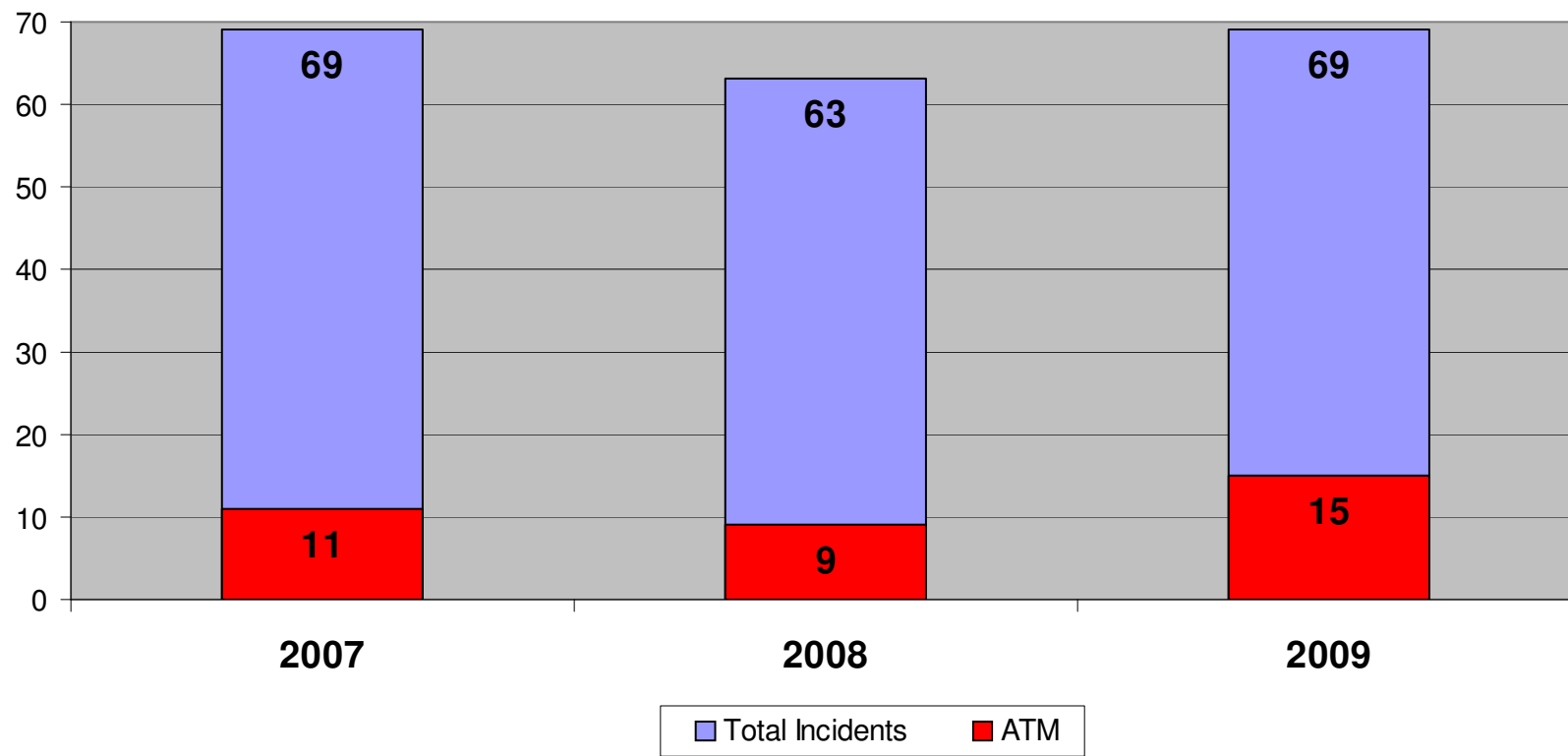

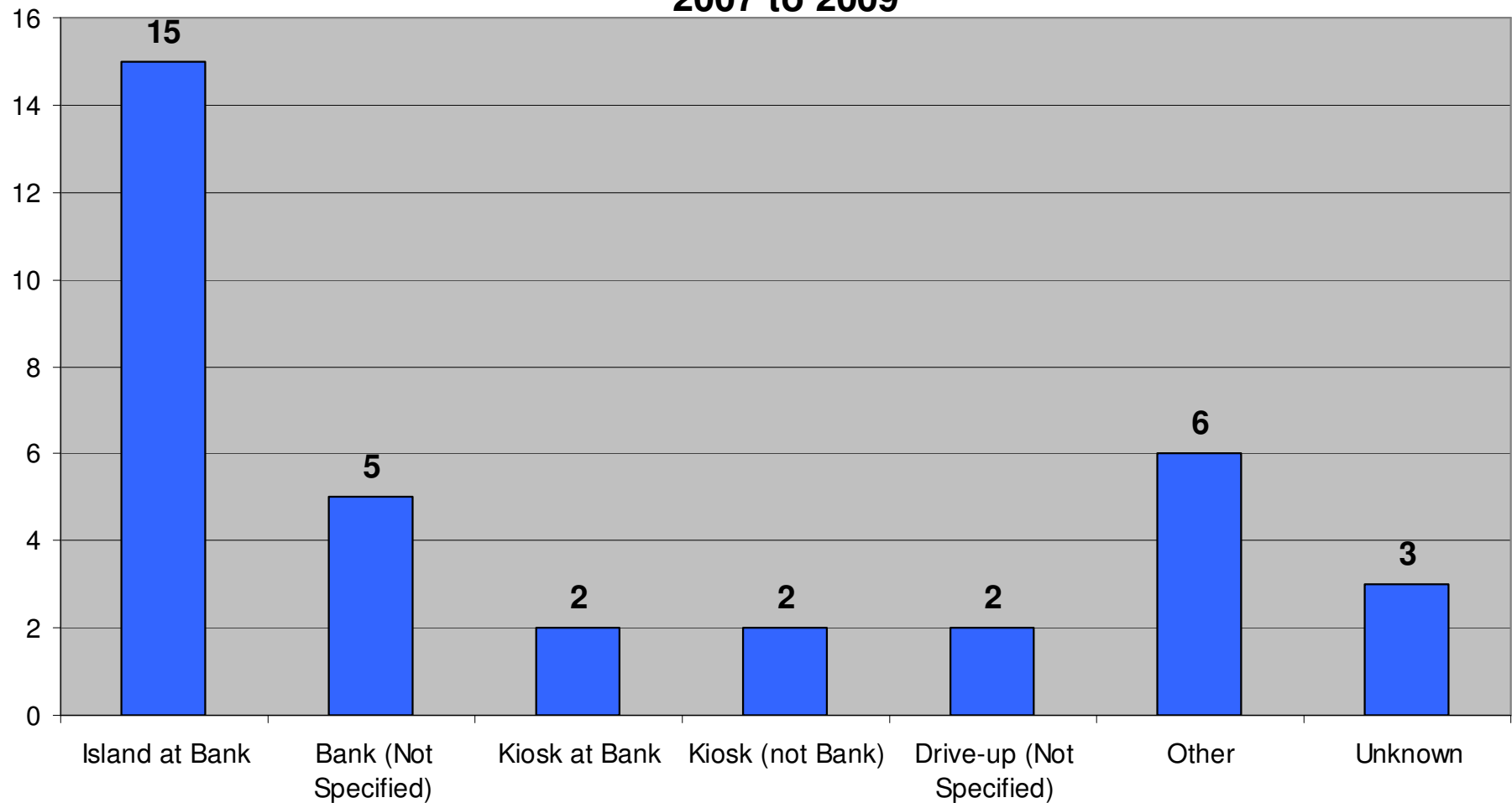

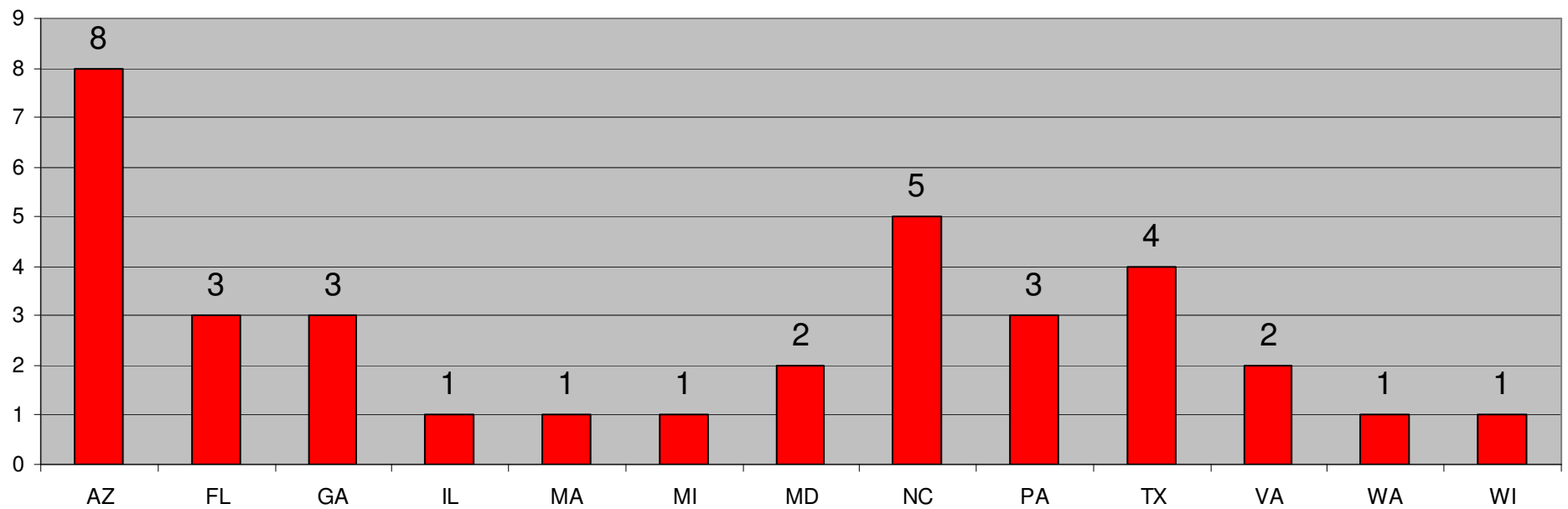

ATM ROBBERIES - LEVEL OF FORCE

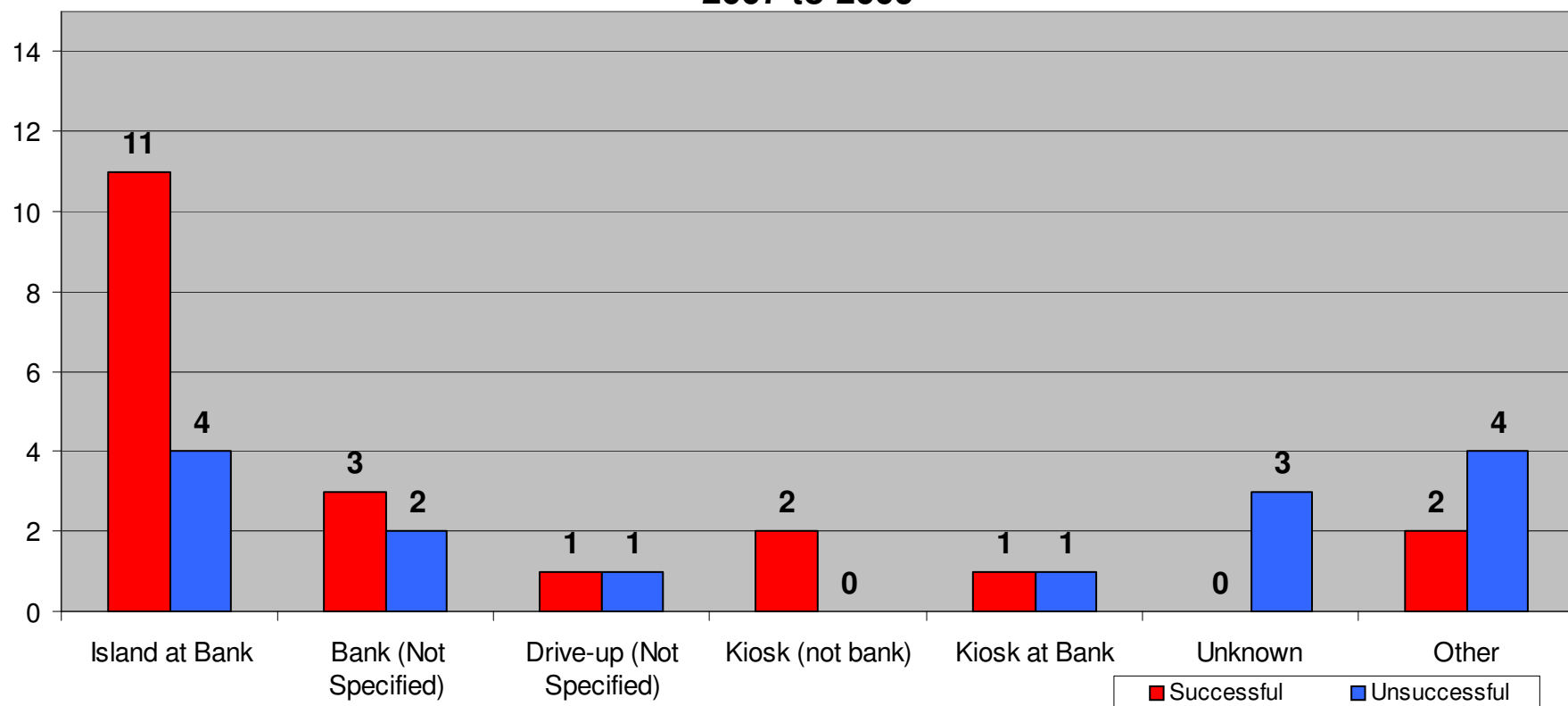

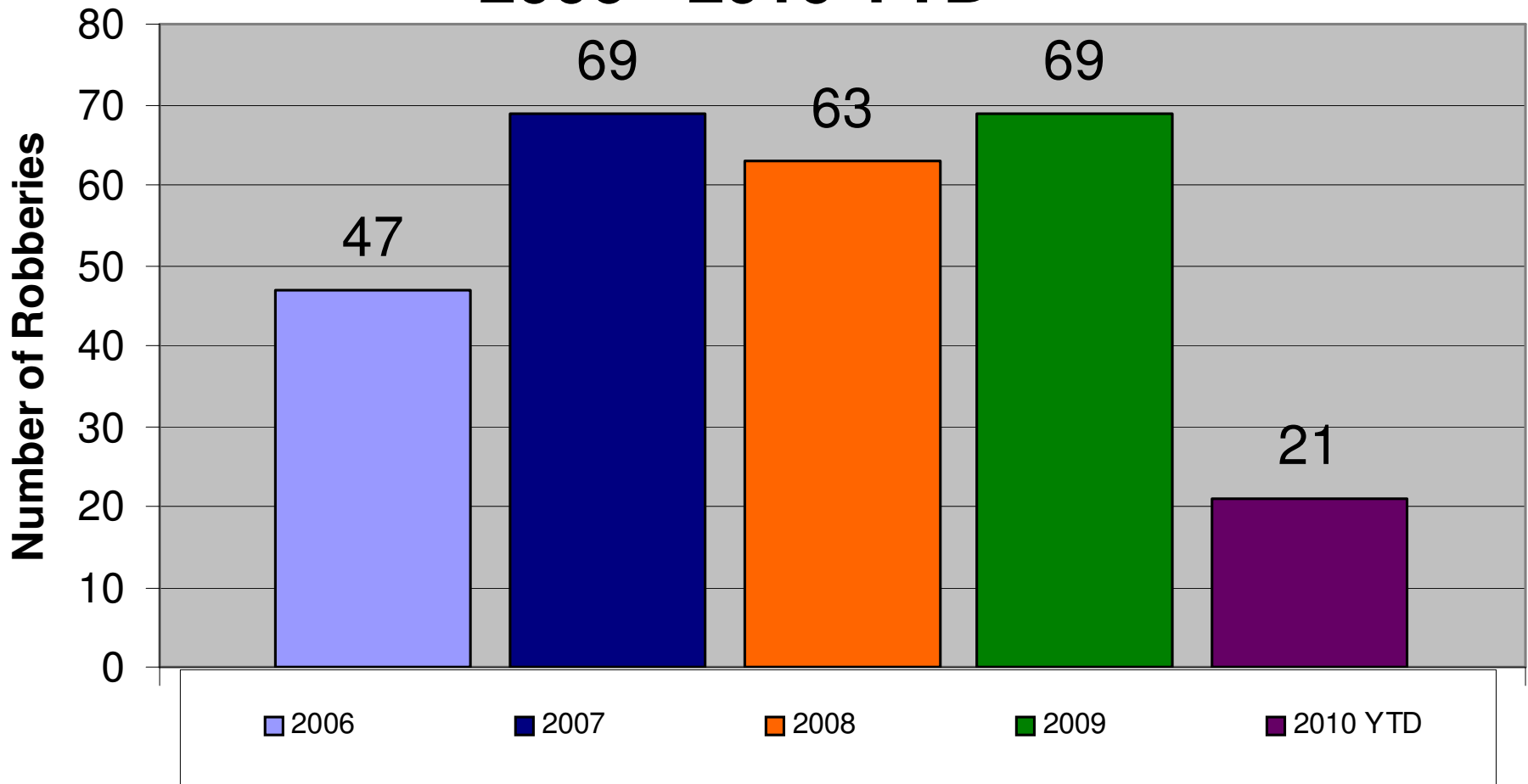

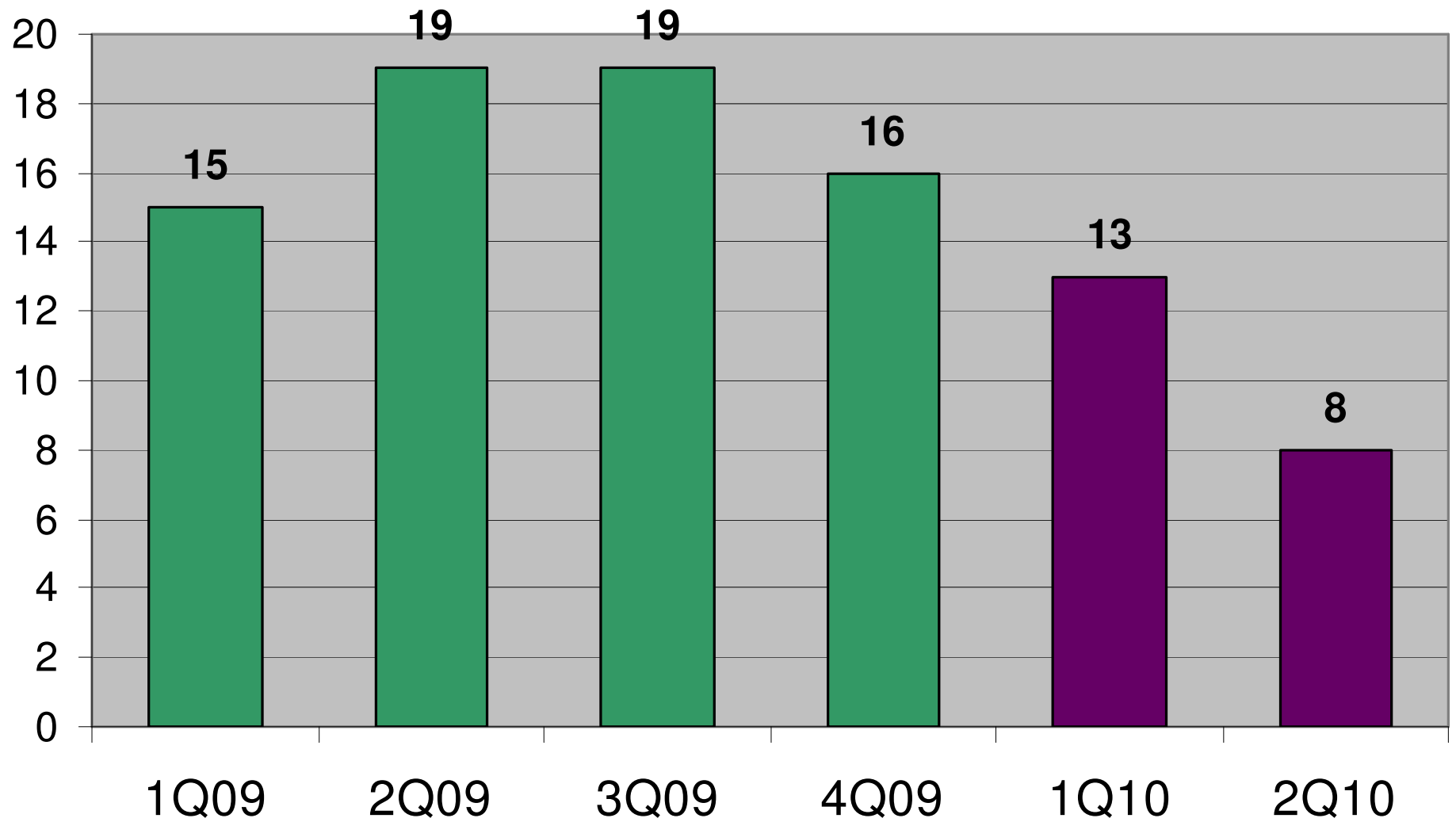

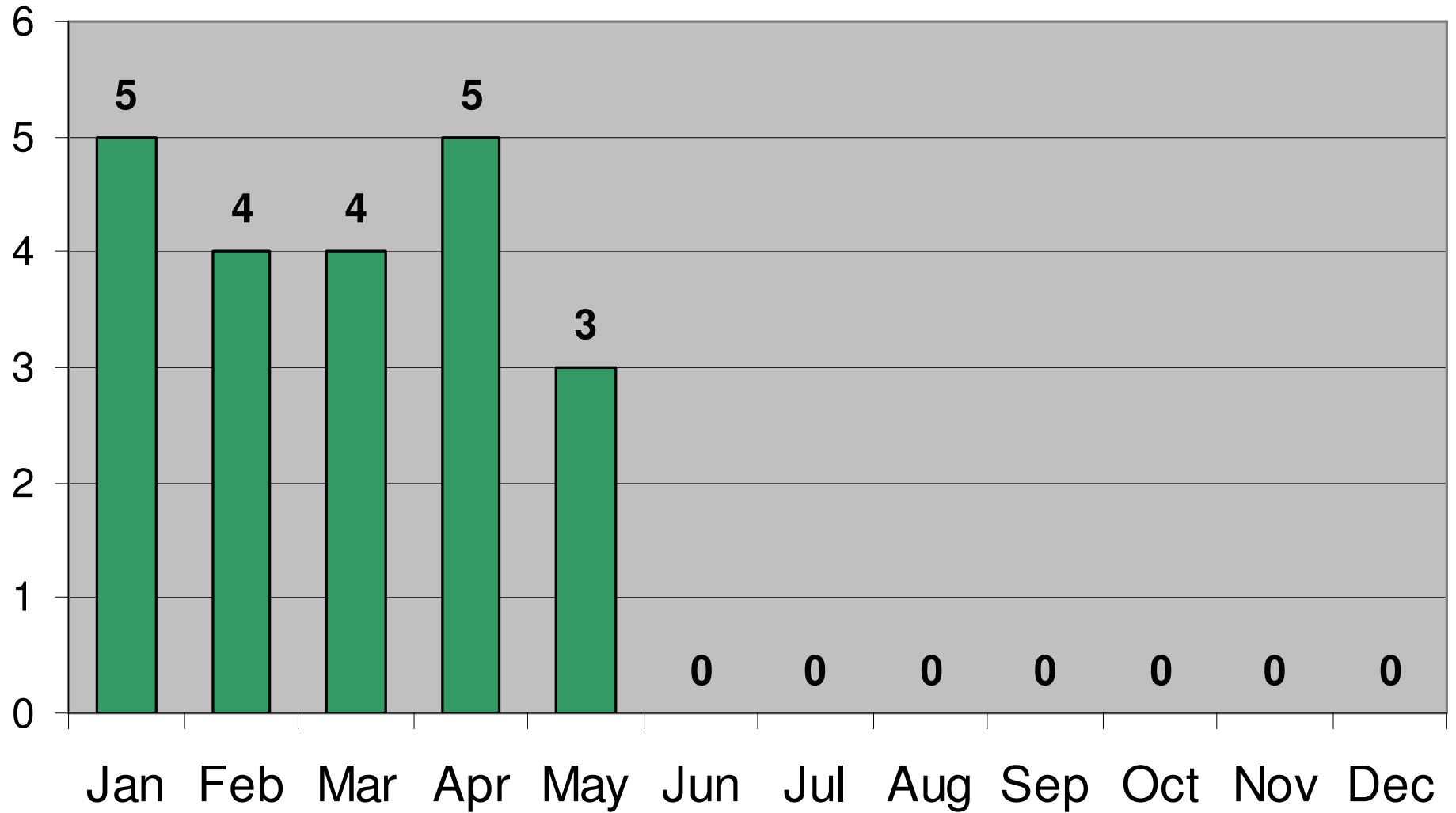
2006 - 2010 YTD



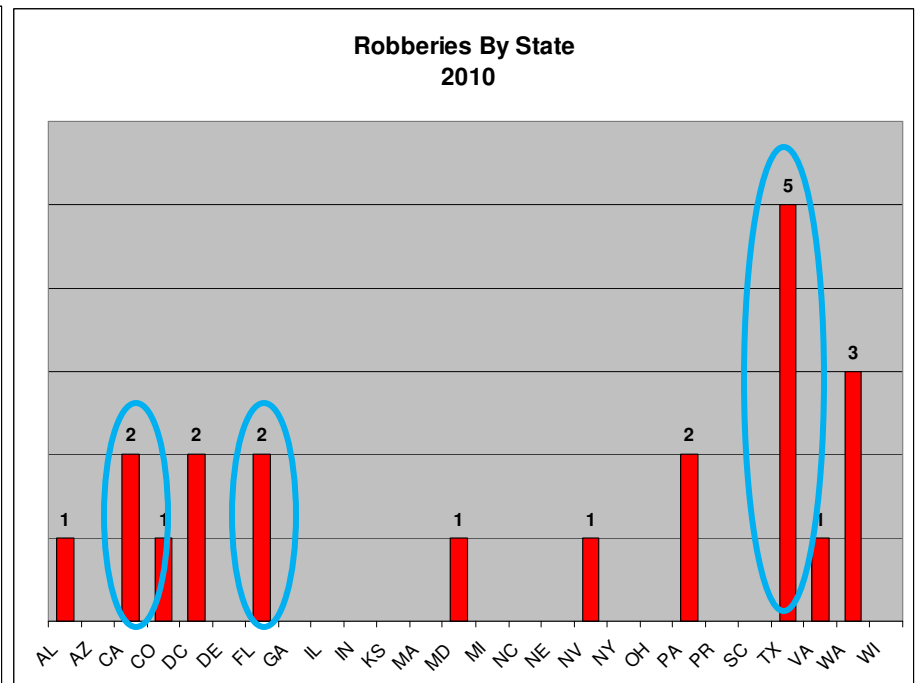
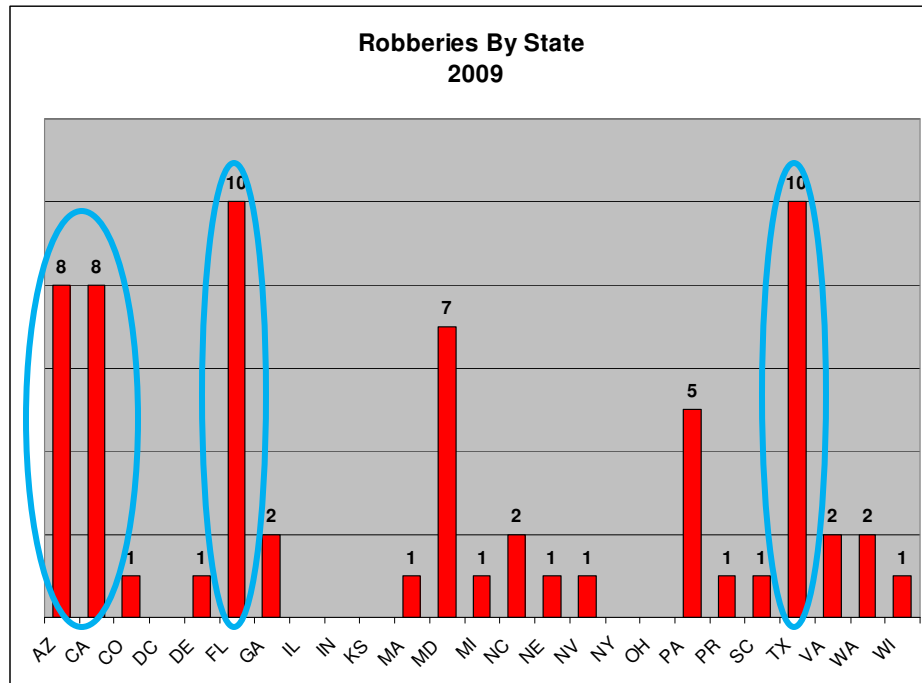
Robberies By Quarter 2009 to 2010 YTD

Triple D - Houston – February 17, 2010

Attempted Homicide of Messenger



HOUSTON (KTRK) - A robbery and shooting occurred in broad daylight this morning outside a southeast Houston grocery store. At least two gunmen ambushed an armored car and shot a security guard before making their escape. The shots rang out just after 11:30am at a busy Kroger store on Telephone at Bellfort.

Brinks Messenger was shot during an attack at a Checker Check Cashing Location. In addition to the Brinks messenger a bystander was struck with shrapnel. This was very similar to two previous Loomis attacks when the assailants immediately begin firing.

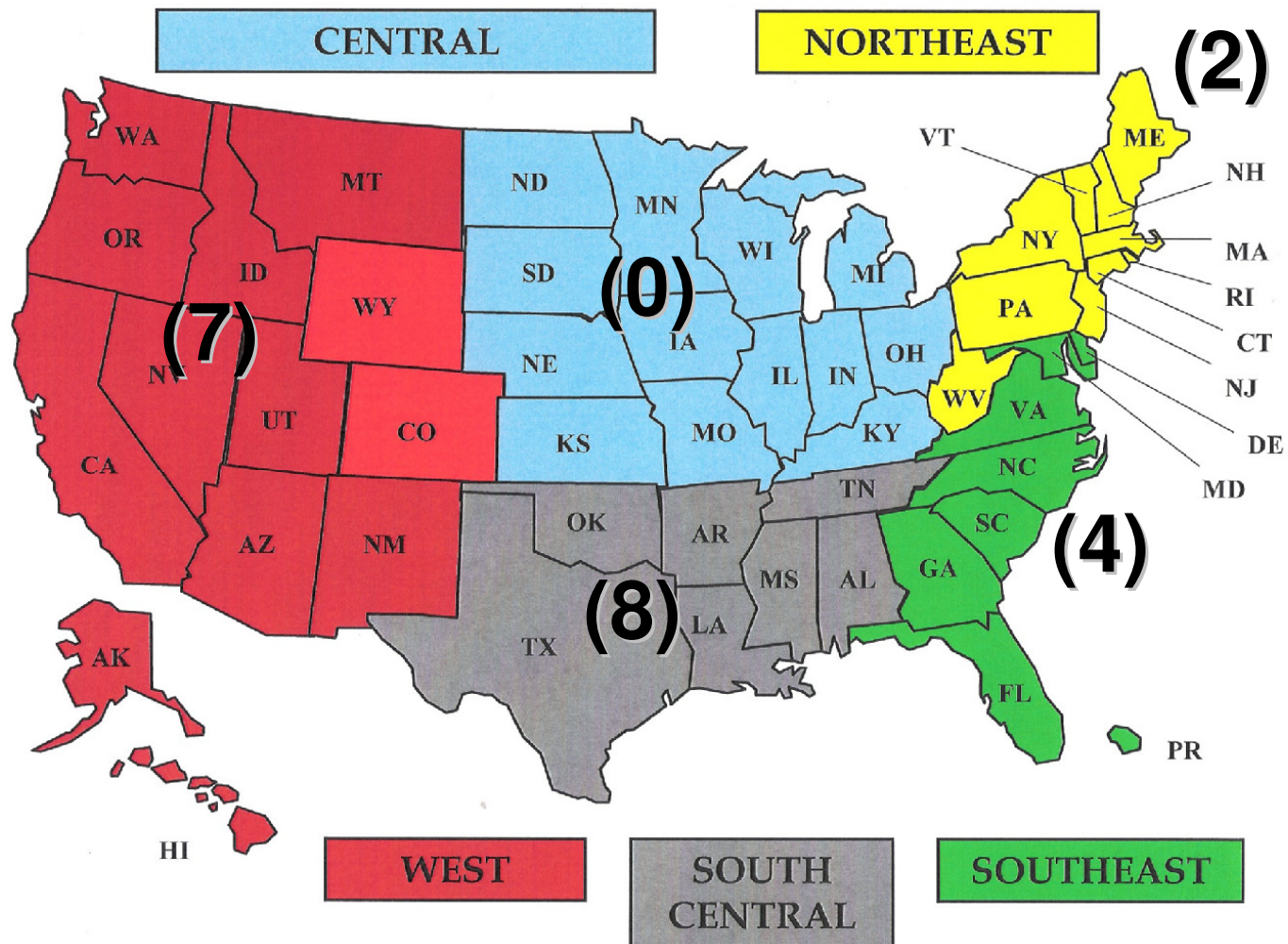

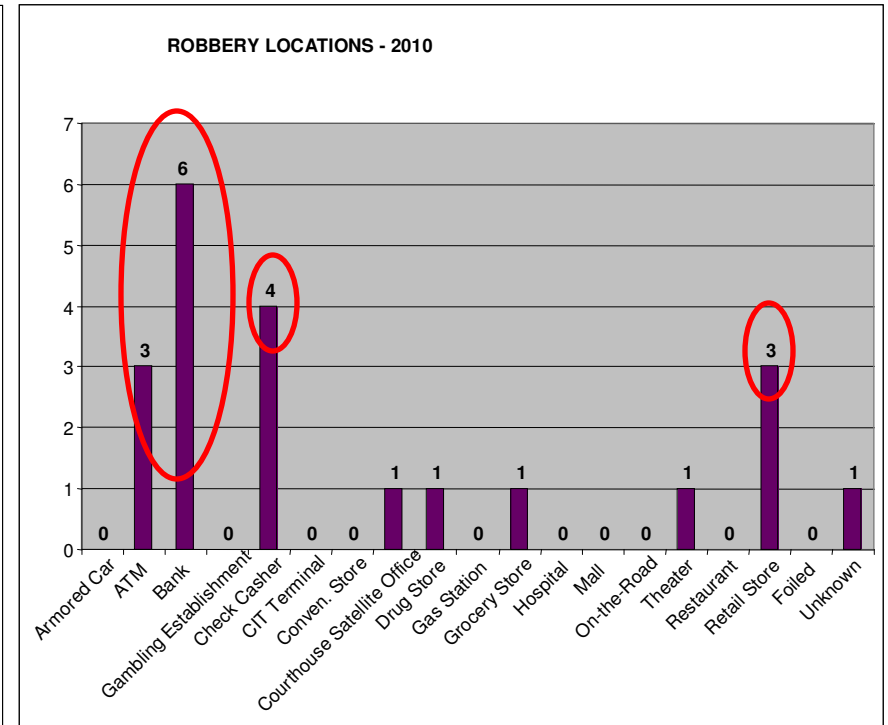
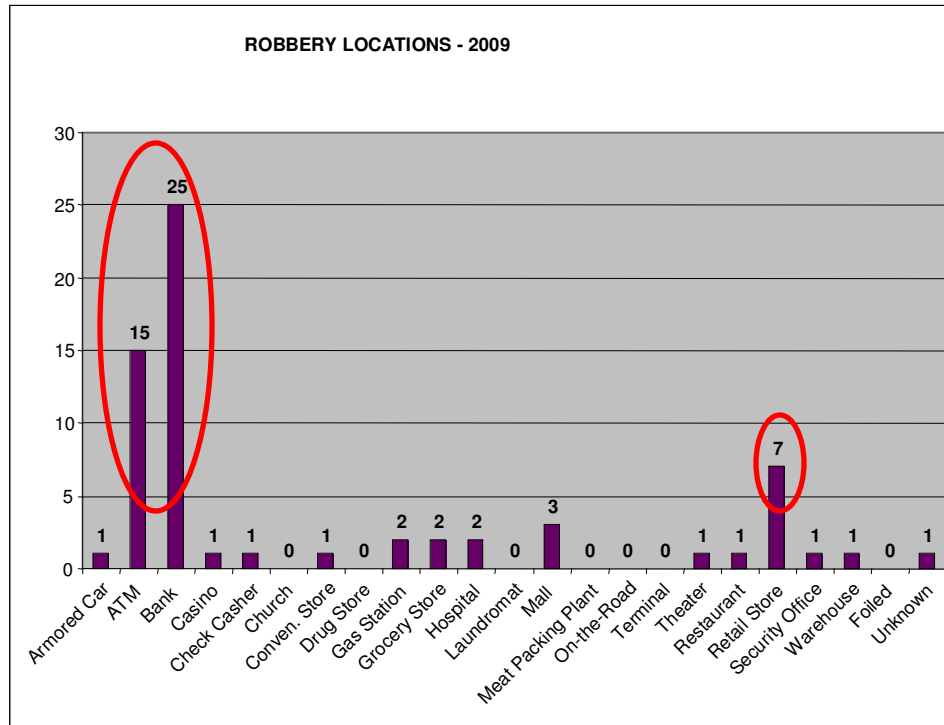


The search is on for three people who robbed a Brinks armored truck Tuesday morning as it made a stop at a Walgreens in Miami Gardens, including a woman who was driving the getaway vehicle. According to the FBI, a Brinks messenger carrying two bags of money was confronted outside of the drug store, located at 15880 NW 27th Avenue around 10:30 a.m. "There was a confrontation around the back of the truck," said FBI spokeswoman Judy Orihuela. "The guard pushed him away. That's when the other robber came up, two shots were fired. The guard was grazed. The shot grazed his pants." After the shooting, the suspects took off running with at least one bag of money.

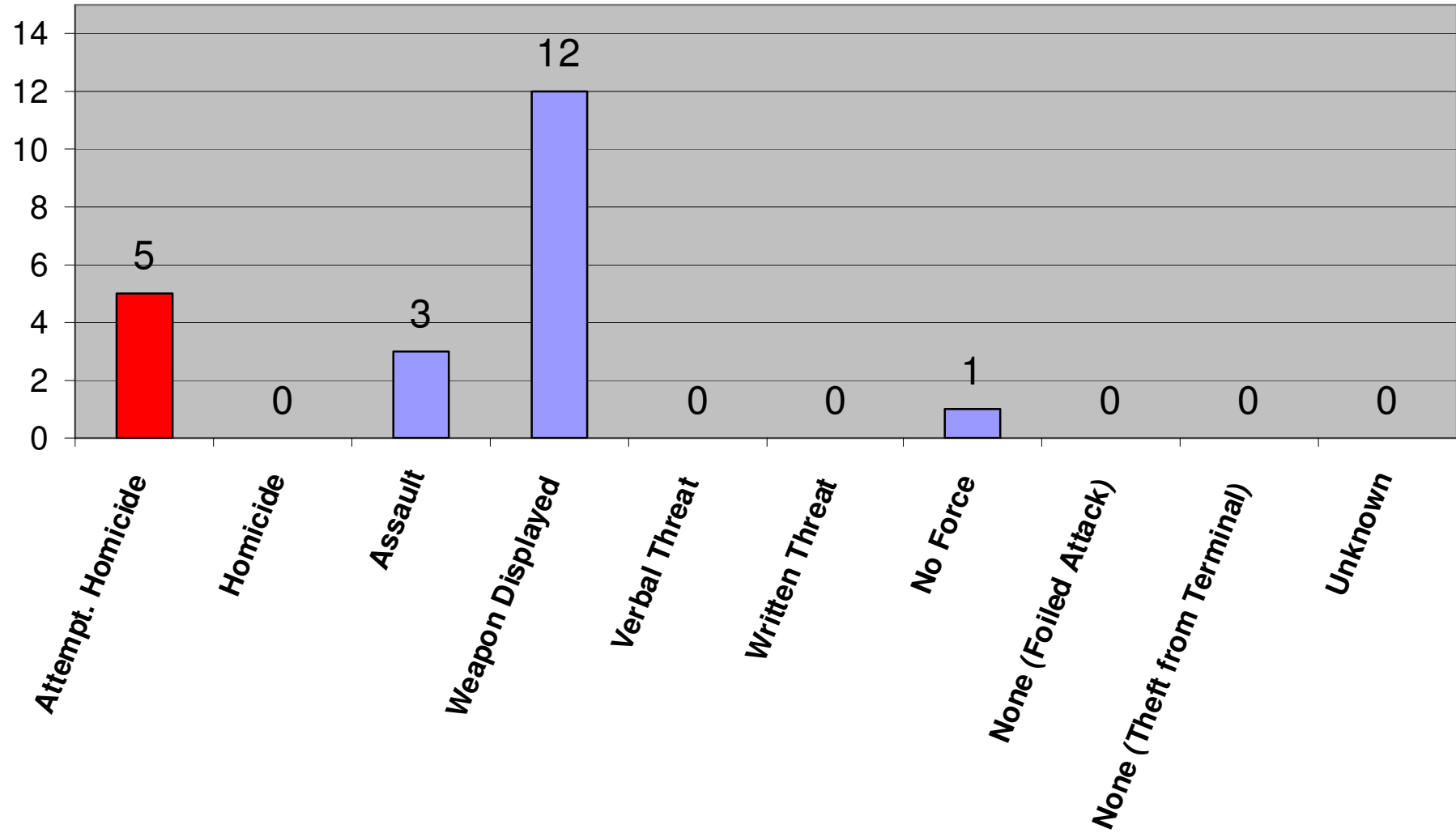
2010 U.S. Armored Car Robberies

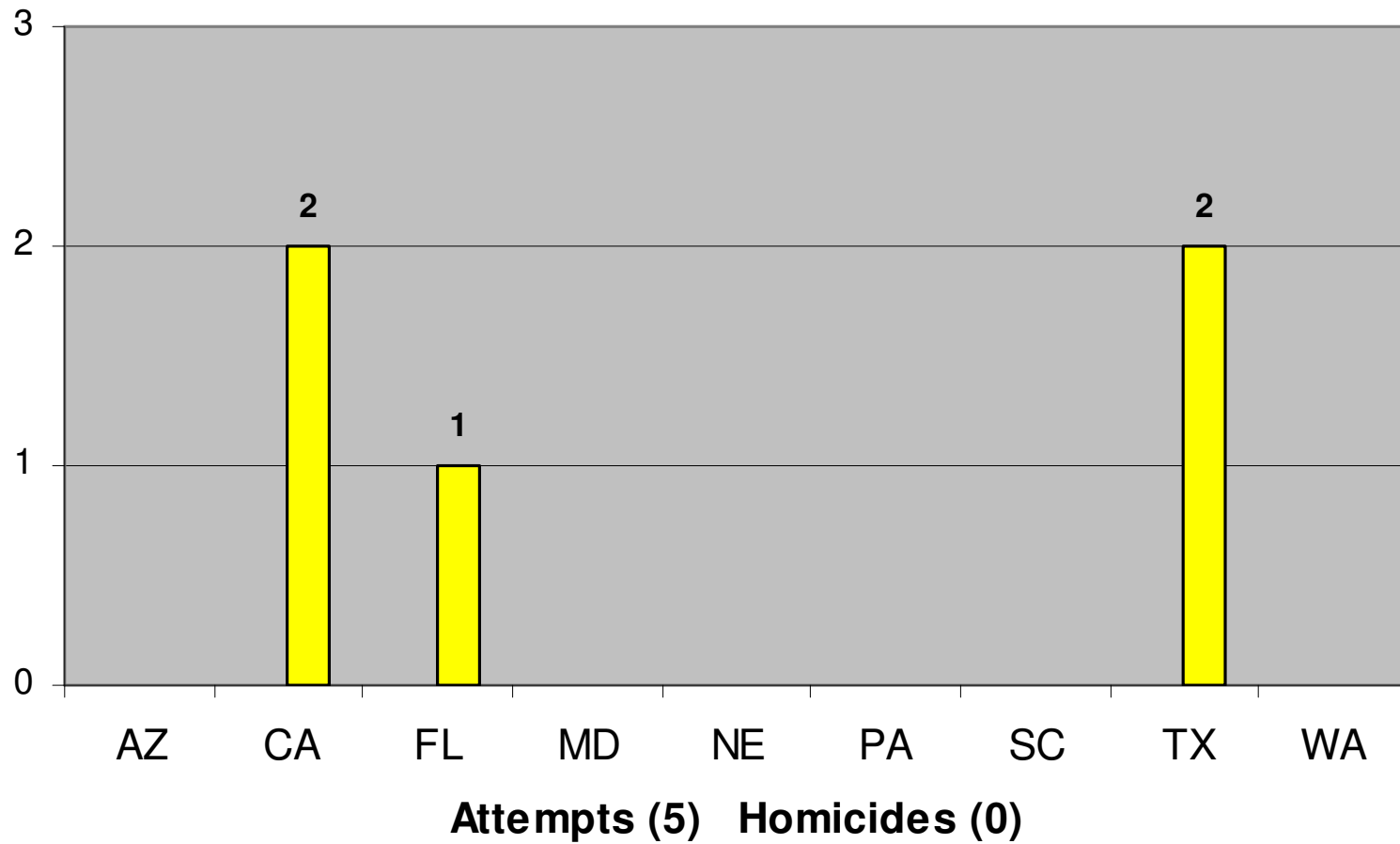


Level of Force Used 2010
