CROSS BORDER CIT

EU Regulation

Scope

- Cross-border transportation ≥ 2 countries euro-area
- Any professional transport
- · By vehicle, by road
- Euro banknotes and coins (≤ 20% value: noneuro cash)
- Daytime transport (6:00-22:00 or exceptions)
- Start from and return to state of origin
- ≥ ½ stops in host state

Excluded transport

- Transport out of scope
- Transport of banknotes between NCB's, escorted by military or police
- Transport of coins between NCB's escorted by military, police or private security

Excluded rules

National law applies to:

- Notification of operations to the police
- Tracking CIT-vehicles by police
- Escort CIT-vehicles by police
- Secured areas and secured locations
- Behaviour employees outside CIT-vehicle

CIT Cross-border licence

Delivered for 5 years by state of origin Conditions:

- Economic activity in state of origin
- For an indefinite period
- Through a stable infrastructure
- Approved in state of origin if not: professional experience ≤ 2 years
- Integrity managers & board members
- Civil liability insurance

Prior information to state of origin and host state

Conditions employees

- Integrity: no relevant criminal/police records
- Physical and mental health: medical certificate
- Cross border CIT training: 200 hours
- Recycling training ≤ 3 years
- Language skills host state

Weapons

 Compliance with legislation of state of origin and host state (training, carry-licence)

 Otherwise weapons in a inaccissible on-board box (remote intervention control centre)

Vehicles and IBNS

Vehicles

- GPS-localisation vehicles by control centre
- Communication tools vehicles with control centre
- Emergency numbers police authorities
- Registration-equipment: time & location cash deliveries/pick-ups
- If armoured: bulletproof vests

If IBNS: homologated in a participating state

► Type of transport: banknotes: pick-up and delivery

Vehicle ordinary appearance – unarmoured	Vehicle – fully- armoured
Vehicle with IBNS- pictogram – unarmoured	
or cabin- or fully- armoured	

► Type of transport: banknotes: point to point transport

From secure location to secure location wich is accessible to vehicles

Fully-armoured vehicle / no IBNS 3 CIT- employees

▶ Type of transport: coins

2 CIT- employees

- Vehicle ordinary appearance unarmoured
- Vehicle with Coins-pictogram cabinarmoured

Mixed transport (banknotes/coins) licit

Remuneration of CIT-employees

- The same working day, the highest minimum rates of pay off:
 - The state off origin
 - The crossed state
 - The host state
- The same working year: if ≥ 100 days cross border work, the highest minimum rates of pay off:
 - The state off origin
 - The crossed state
 - The host state

Penalties

- Member state of origin control de rules of the regulation. Sanctions:
 - Warning
 - Fine
 - Suspension of licence
 - Prohibition of licence for 5 years
- Host member states can:
 - Suspend transport on its territory for 2 months
 - Sanction on basis of excluded rules
