





### 1. Modelling of recirculation ratios (aggregated model, without manual handling)




# Processing volumes of NCBs and banks/cash handlers






- → Very pronounced differences in NCBs' involvement in the cash cycle
- → NCBs have started defining targets for their operational involvement in the cash cycle
- → ECB oversees developments




- Banks/cash handlers processed EUR 937 billion
- NCBs processed EUR 1,030 billion

#### 4. Recirculation ratios: banks vs. other cash handlers




Recirculation ratios highest for €50, €20 and €10 (preferred ATMs denominations)



 Around 119,000 banknote handling machines in use in 17 euro area Member States

#### Cash recycling machines vs ATMs



28,381 CRMs installed

In addition, 256,411 ATMs/cash dispensers in use

=> 10% of all cash dispensers in the euro area are CRMs, 90% without recycling function



- → High engagement of various NCBs in testing with equipment manufacturers
- → Onsite monitoring control of banknote handling machines increasing
- → Common "best practice" document for monitoring by NCBs being prepared by ECB

#### 8. IBNS and impact on ECB Decision

- ECB is working on common detection criteria (thresholds) for machine detection of IBNS ink-stains
- Implementing rules on the detection and withdrawal of IBNS-stained notes call for standardisation of some technical IBNS features:
  - Uniform visual appearance (?)
  - Uniform machine-readable properties
- New policy, if adopted, will trigger amendment of ECB Recirculation Decision and procedures for automated and manual processing (Annexes II, III)







### 9. Latest activities regarding IBNS

- Following closure of ECB R&D project works continues on policy and technical aspects
  - Detection criteria done



- Ist BHM passed tests at NBB in June 2015
- Prototype of software for NCB sorters scheduled for Q3/2015
- ECB is launching survey on the use of IBNS by banks, CITs and others
  - Number/share of entities using IBNS?
  - Number/share of ATMs/CRMs protected?
  - Share of ATMs/CRMs and banknotes in transit protected?
