Pandemic impacts on cash in France

Means of payment competition

- → Contactless maximum raised to 50€
- → No minimum amount to use contactless!
- → Contactless payment prefered in a number of retail chains

Economic crisis


- → Traditional cash paying tourists (american, chinese, germans and russians) are deserting France
- → Tourism: Côte d'Azur and Paris metropole strongly impacted
- → Large impact of lockdown in may and april
- → >100 billions € placed by french people in savings (cash savings too)
- → A lot of people are in partial employment, earn less money and so have less money to spend.

Fake news


 → Massive campaign against cash in press and social media: cash carries virus



Pandemic impacts on cash in Loomis France




Means of payment: behaviour change





In transactions

Transactions - Focus on card payments, cash and cheques (in volume, billion)



What we can expect?



Volumes are down by 10% to 15%



Some retailers are still refusing cash but some are now refusing contactless payment too, because of fees.



We can expect an increase of volumes by 5% when tourism returns

But : nobody can foresee what the near future will be (weeks and months) The French government will announce tomorrow new measures (partial lockdown, new restrictions).
